Background

March 13, 2023 (council initiation) Nov. 6, 2023 (council study session)

- General support for the LUCA
- Questions relating to:
 - How Bellevue compares to other jurisdictions
 - How we can improve clarity and predictability around extension requests

Objectives

- Allow extensions to design review approvals
- Allow projects to adapt to unforeseen circumstances
- Minimize financial impact of expiring permits to property owners and the City
- Address concerns associated with projects not being required to comply with updated code



Current Code

- Design Review approvals expire pursuant to LUC 20.40.500
- No opportunity for extension

BDC Feedback

- Reinforced need for certainty in extension approval
- Expressed support for longer approval period
- General support from BDC for 3-year approval with 2-year extension



Additional Stakeholder Feedback

Additional Feedback Separate from BDC:

- Suggestions to improve clarity of draft LUCA
- Request for multiple 2-year extensions, without limit

Design Review Extension Options

Option	Approval Period	Extension Amount	Total Duration
Option A Recommended	3 years	2-years (up to 2 extensions)	7 years
Option B	Same	2-years (<u>unlimited</u> extensions)	<u>Unlimited</u>

Option A – Recommended LUCA

Approach:

- 3-year approval
- Up to 2, 2-year
 extensions when project
 conforms to applicable
 regulations
- Maximum time: 7 years

Considerations:

- Approval period and extensions are regionally competitive
- Balances flexibility for projects and transparency for public
- Generally supported by the BDC

Option B

Approach:

- 3-year approval
- Unlimited 2-year
 extensions when project
 conforms to applicable
 regulations
- Maximum time: Unlimited

Considerations:

- Approval extensions far exceed neighboring jurisdictions
- Offers ultimate flexibility to projects; may result in less transparency for the public
- No input from the BDC
- Challenging to track and administer

Decision Criteria

LUC 20.30J.135 establishes the decision criteria for LUCAs

- A. The amendment is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan
- B. The amendment enhances the public health, safety or welfare
- C. The amendment is not contrary to the best interests of the citizens and property owners of the City of Bellevue

Option B	Same	2-years (<u>unlimited</u> extensions)	Unlimited
