#### ARCH Interlocal Agreement: Basic Housing Trust Fund Provisions

#### ARCH Responsibilities and Authority:

- Recommend funding for affordable housing and, through administering agency, execute contracts and covenants to fund approved projects
- Facilitate public-private cooperation with developers, financial institutions, and other entities
- Monitor affordable units and administer direct service housing programs

#### <u>Citizen Advisory Board</u>

- Up to 15-member body of community members with professional expertise and commitment to affordable housing in East King County
- Provides advice and recommendations to the ARCH Executive Board on resource allocation

#### Housing Trust Fund Account


• Established by Administering Agency (Bellevue), with sub-accounts for each city and project.

Cities annually determine available resources. ARCH and statewide funders announce funding guidelines & application forms.	ARCH solicits interest from the development community and meets with potential applicants to provide guidance.	Applications are thoroughly vetted by ARCH staff, city staff liaisons and the Citizen Advisory Board based on adopted priorities and criteria.	ARCH works with other local and state funders to coordinate resources and maximize leverage of local funds.	ARCH Executive Board considers the recommenda- tion of the CAB before advancing a final recommenda- tion to City Councils.




