








Ashwood Park Site Plan 1990 Adopted Resolution No. 5338





Which Plan is closest to representing the park you would like to see?



Which off-leash area do you prefer?



Has Alternative Plan F found a balance between open space and hardscape?




No - too much open space


## Park Naming Policy

Council Resolution No. 10151 provides policies and procedures for naming public parks and recreation facilities based upon public input using the following criteria:

- a neighborhood or geographical identification;
- a natural or geographical feature;
- a historical figure or name of historical or cultural significance;
- an organization or individual that has made a significant contribution to the park system; and
- In the case of names for individuals or historic figures, consideration of diversity, equity and inclusion.
