Whereas: Domestic violence is a serious crime impacting individuals of all socioeconomic

backgrounds, races, genders, faiths, orientations and abilities; and

Whereas: Domestic violence is widespread and has a devastating impact on survivors,

children, families and our community; and

Whereas: Since 1997, approximately 380 domestic violence incidents in Bellevue resulted

in fatalities—including 288 homicide cases, 68 suicides and 24 cases involving

law enforcement intervention; and

Whereas: Additionally, the Bellevue Police Department responds to approximately 1,200

domestic violence cases per year, with about 870 incidents in 2024 to date; and

Whereas: Historically marginalized populations including LGBTQ+, persons with

disabilities, immigrants and refugees, people of color, and Indigenous people face some of the highest rates of domestic and sexual violence, along with

additional systemic barriers to safety and support; and

Whereas: Domestic violence is sustained by indifference. Ending the cycle of this vicious

crime requires the support of the larger community for courageous survivors;

and

**Whereas:** Education, prevention and intervention efforts to end the cycle of domestic

violence are imperative to not only protect survivors but also to increase public awareness of the severity and extent of domestic violence and its far-reaching

impacts.

**Now, therefore, I,** Lynne Robinson, Mayor of the City of Bellevue, Washington, and on behalf of its City Council, do hereby proclaim the month of **October 2024** as:

## **Domestic Violence Action Month**

in Bellevue and urge all residents to speak out against domestic violence and support local efforts to prevent and end domestic abuse in our communities.
