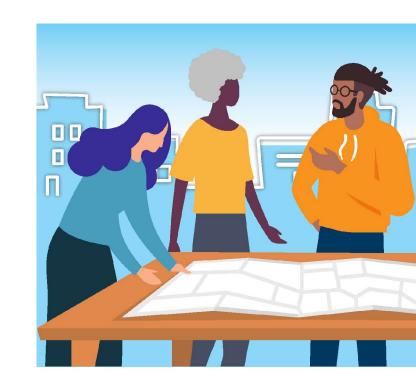

What is the Affordable Housing Strategy?

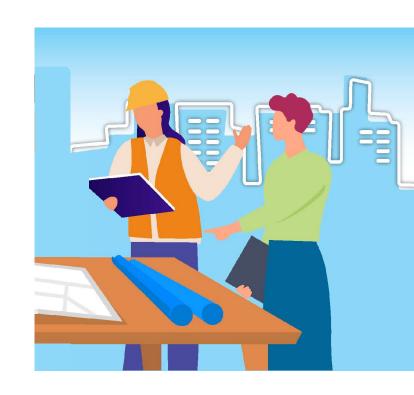
- Functional or strategic plan
- Implements new Comprehensive Plan policy guidance
- Near-term and focused on increasing housing affordability



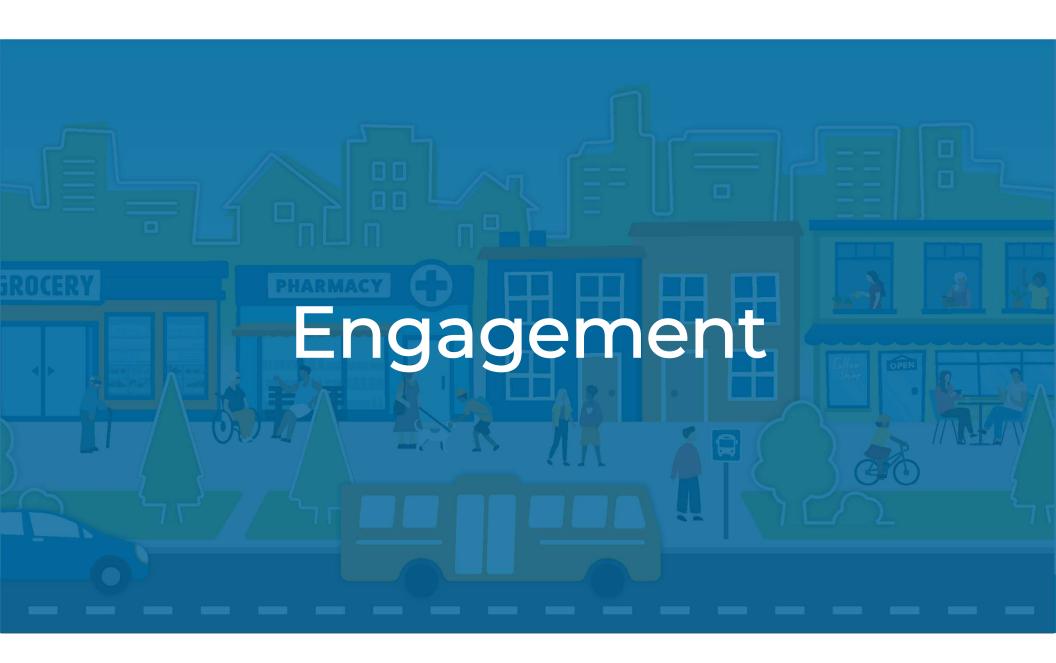


What is the Affordable Housing Strategy?

- Focused on, but not exclusive to, income-restricted <u>Affordable</u>
 <u>H</u>ousing
- Identifies implementation steps for the City within an action plan

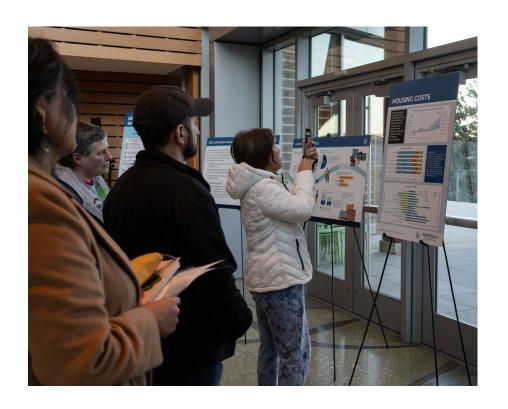

Phase 1

- Connected with...
 - Almost 300 people
 - Over 25 organizations
- Collected 20 housing stories and 37 film reflections
- What we heard publish in Phase 1 engagement report



Phase 2

Focused on engaging those closest to housing issues to help assess actions

Partner Survey - Aimed to understand challenges, opportunities, and tradeoffs

- 59 responses from a range of organizations
- Key themes were
 - Reducing costs
 - Improving navigation
 - Balancing trade-offs

Community Facilitator Program - Utilizes community members' existing connections to reach those most impacted

- 9 community facilitators hired
- Over 150 community members reached through listening sessions
- Key themes were around access and information barriers





Goals

- Derived from Comprehensive Plan
- Prioritize achieving the new affordable housing target





Affordable Housing Target

10-Year Target 2026-2036





Draft Strategies

- 29 draft strategies, each with one to six actions
- "Mechanisms" include code changes, process updates, guidance, advocacy, and communications, amongst others
- Weighted towards actions that build or preserve incomerestricted affordable housing
- Overlap with work of Office of Housing study on funding



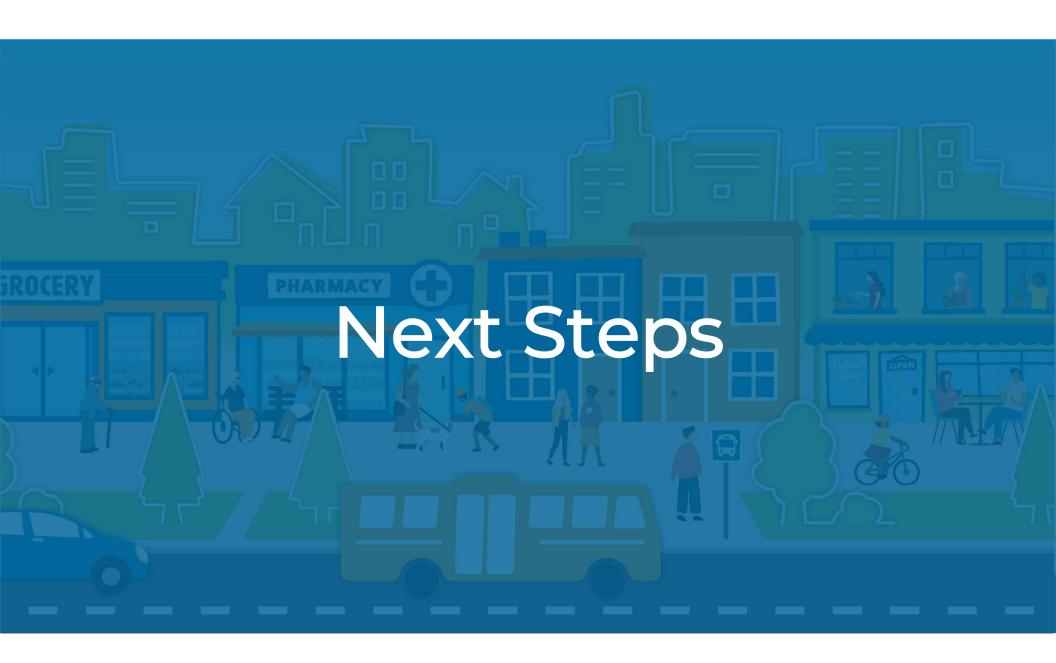
Select Draft Strategies

Under Affordable Housing goal:

- Acquire and rehabilitate Naturally Occurring Affordable Housing (NOAH)
- Acquire property to bank for affordable housing
- 3. Assess and shore up existing affordable housing portfolio
- Create a permissible land use code for 10. Expand and monitor affordable affordable housing
- 5. light rail stations

- Support qualifying properties (C-1)
- Explore new local revenue sources and financing tools
- Reduce costs and timelines for affordable housing
- Increase capacity to develop and 9. operate within Bellevue
- housing programs
- Ensure affordable housing around new 11. Leverage city resources for affordable housing





Next Steps

- Vet prioritization approach
- Draft the 2025 Strategy
- Present the draft to Council in January 2026
- Planning Commission update in Q1
- Implementation!
