

## **Next Right Work**

- Builds upon Affordable Housing Strategy
- Designed to increase production of <u>market-rate & affordable</u> <u>housing</u>

Approved by City Council June 5, 2017






# Objective of Downtown IOC\*


- Quickly respond to application-ready projects
- Test FAR increase and measure against policy objectives
- Encourage residential development
- Increase Affordable Housing production

\* IOC expires Nov 16



## **Current Utilization**


- IOC Adopted May 8, 2023
- Applies Downtown, except **DT-OB** and Perimeter Overlay A-1
- Four projects submitted under IOC
- Projects include:
  - 4,750 market-rate units; and
  - 285 affordable units



## **IOC Ordinance No. 6760**

#### No changes from previous IOC

- Increased FAR exemption
- Development flexibility in Perimeter
  - 25' height increase
  - 15' stepback reduction
  - 5% lot coverage increase
- No minimum parking for Affordable Housing
- "Movement" flexibility for FAR



## **IOC/LUCA Process**

- If extended, IOC expires May 17, 2024
- Permanent regulations developed through CPPU and LUCA process
- IOC not permanent or intended to adversely affect Council's ability to adopt LUCA that differs from IOC

Phase 1 IOC adopted May 8, 2023

Public Hearing IOC Extension Oct 23, 2023

IOC Expiration Nov 16, 2023 IOC Expires (if extended) May 2024
