SUBJECT: Agenda Item 2a - Ordinance 6419

At their June 25 Extended Study Session, the City Council began a process of discussing proposed amendments to Ordinance 6419. If adopted, the legislation would add a new section to the Bellevue Land Use Code providing regulations for the permitting of Homeless Services Uses.

To date, Council has discussed and voted on amendments presented in Attachments E and C of the published agenda memorandum, with decisions made as follows:

- Amendments E-1, E-2, E-5, E-7, E-8, and E-9 were approved as presented by a vote of 7 – 0.
- Amendments E-4, E-6, E-10 were approved 7 – 0 with amendments.
- Amendment E-3 was withdrawn from consideration.
- Amendment E-11 will be redrafted for the July 9 agenda packet with language to restrict Code of Conduct requirements to the immediate vicinity of a sited shelter.
- Amendment C-1 was rejected by a vote of 3 - 4. Council then approved an amendment to encourage Large Overnight Shelters of more than 50 beds to be located within one mile of a public transit stop by a vote of 7 – 0.

Last week's agenda memorandum has been republished in tonight's packet, as Council will continue discussion of amendments related to *Permit Process Path Alternatives (Attachment D)* and *Good Neighbor Advisory Committee Member Group (Attachment B)*. A synthesis amendment presented in last Monday's desk packet has been added to Attachment B.

Additional time will be scheduled during the July 16 meeting for additional discussion and possible adoption of the Ordinance.
