EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**ACTION**

This Resolution authorizes the purchase and installation of new play equipment at Crossroads Community Park and demolition of existing play equipment by GameTime, in an amount not to exceed \$424,477, plus all applicable taxes.

RECOMMENDATION

Move to adopt Resolution No. 10355.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The current play equipment at Crossroads Community Park was installed more than 20 years ago and has reached the end of its useful life cycle. City staff selected the proposed new play equipment after working with Crossroads Community Center staff and a design team to incorporate the most inclusive elements which meet the local needs for the budget available. The accessible components of the play structures include more than 20 elements accessible by ground, 15 accessible by ramp, and 12 raised components accessible by transfer platforms throughout the three different play areas. This new playground, maximizing inclusive elements, will be a great addition for all park users for many years to come.

The purchase will utilize a cooperative purchasing agreement with Omnia Partners that allows the City to secure very competitive pricing.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS**Policy Impact**

The Parks, Recreation and Open Space element of the Bellevue Comprehensive Plan supports the purchase and installation of the new equipment.

PA-34. Evaluate existing parks and facilities, renovate, where appropriate, to maximize efficient maintenance and operation practices, improve safety and accessibility for all users, and to reduce, where feasible, the impacts on adjacent properties.

This purchase is supported by the adoption of the City's Diversity Advantage Plan in 2014 that included the goals of promoting access and compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990.

Bellevue City Code Chapter 4.28 provides for the fair and equitable treatment of all persons involved in the purchasing process. Council approval is required to execute contracts that exceed \$350,000.

Fiscal Impact

This action will obligate the City to an amount not to exceed \$424,477, plus all applicable taxes. This project is funded in the 2023-2029 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) through CIP Plan No. P-R-11, Renovation and Refurbishment of Park Facilities.

OPTIONS

1. Adopt the Resolution authorizing the purchase and installation of new play equipment at Crossroads Community Park and demolition of existing play equipment by GameTime, in an amount not to exceed \$424,477, plus all applicable taxes.
2. Do not adopt the Resolution and provide alternative direction to staff.
