	Intermittent NB/SB lane closures








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Lakemont Blvd. Emergency Project

Traffic Impact


Road closed until June 2024: Lakemont Boulevard SE / Newcastle Golf Club Road between Red Town Trailhead and 155th Avenue SE.




Traffic Impacts

- Intermittent lane closures starting January 2024.
- Full lane closures starting March 2024.
- Five lanes reduced to one northbound lane and two southbound lanes.

Coordination between Bellevue and WSDOT

- Joint traffic analysis Factoria Blvd. Project and Sunset Creek Fish Passage Project sharing of traffic data and analysis
- City/WSDOT bi-weekly coordination meetings
- Ongoing traffic monitoring by City staff and signal timing adjustments
- City and WSDOT Contractor coordination to adjust operations as needed

- Inform why these projects are needed.
- Advise on ways to mitigate impact.
- Use accessible language to reach the City's diverse communities impacted by these projects.
