

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6872

AN ORDINANCE establishing time-restricted parking along the east and west sides of 130th Ave NE between NE Spring Blvd. and NE 20th St.; authorizing the City Manager or their designee to set the parking restriction time limits, which may vary from 3-minute parking to 4-hour parking, and the hours that the time restrictions are in effect, which may be from as early as 7 a.m. to as late as 8 p.m.; and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, Policy S-BR-91 of the BelRed Subarea Plan establishes a City policy to manage the parking supply and consider establishing maximum parking requirements to encourage the use of transit, car/van pool, and non-motorized commute options; and

WHEREAS, Policy M.2.3 of the Environmental Stewardship Plan (2021-2025) establishes a City policy to explore strategies to effectively manage curbside space for a variety of uses such as ride-share, buses, pedestrians and other needs; and

WHEREAS, Policy TR-119 of the Transportation Element of the Comprehensive Plan establishes a City policy to provide flexible curbside space within public right-of-way to accommodate parcel delivery and passenger loading through development review and curb operation changes. Now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The parking of vehicles on the following streets may be restricted to certain time limits or during specified times of the day when signs are present:

- A. The east and west sides of 130th Ave NE between NE Spring Blvd and NE 20th St.

Section 2. The City Manager or their designee is authorized to establish time-limited parking or time-of-day parking restrictions on all or portions of the specific streets in Section 1 through the use of signs. Time limits may vary from 3-minute parking to 4-hour parking and the hours of daily restrictions may be in effect from as early as 7 a.m. to as late as 8 p.m.

Section 3. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its passage and legal publication.
