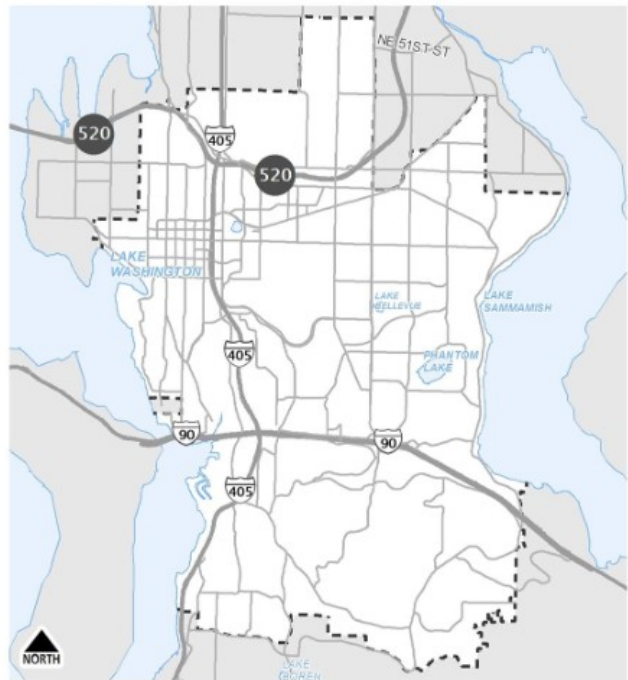


King County Parks Levy (2020-2025)



Budget to Complete

This proposal funds parks system capital improvement projects using pass-through funds from the 2020-2025 King County voter-approved Parks, Recreation, Trails, and Open Space Levy. Funded projects can include property acquisition, natural area conservation and park and trail development. Projects that connect Bellevue parks and trails to regional recreation resources are prioritized for this funding source to improve regional access for Bellevue residents.

This levy was first approved in 2007, and renewed in 2013 and 2019. Levy funds are restricted to uses defined in King County Ordinance 18890, which include city park system operations and capital improvement projects. Previous projects funded through this project have acquired new park property and improved parks and trails that connect to regional recreational resources such as King County’s Eastrail trail or Cougar Mountain Regional Wildland Park.
