- Public access and benefits
- Project feasibility

2026 Request

Artists and organizations submitted 67 Project grant applications totaling \$464,000 in funding requests.

2026 Allocations

Project Grants

- \$187,000 total
- 31 grants

BelRed Bonus

- \$13,000 total
- 13 grants, \$1,000 each

Total allocation: \$200,000

Example: Rohini Mathur

Pollinator Hubs: Bees & Butterflies in Bloom

- Outdoor community art installation
- Offer educational and artistic resources
- Community painting days to decorate hubs



Example: Gage Academy of Art

Teen Art Studio (TAS)

- Free weekly drop-in art program for teens
- Students learn from professional teachers
- Art supplies and a meal are provided
- Recommended for a BelRed Bonus
