Background

On June 1, 2023, the Commission will meet at City Hall and travel by van to visit four sites that will highlight the Utilities Department's environmental stewardship work, operations and maintenance of Utilities' infrastructure, and capital project delivery for selected projects. The following sites will be included on the tour:

- Peamouth Migration Viewing at Kelsey Creek Wildlife Viewing Platform
- Kelsey Creek Culvert & Water/Sewer Main Replacement Project at Lake Hills Boulevard
- Fatoria Boulevard Stormwater Conveyance Improvements Project
- Bellefield Pump Station Operations and Bellefield Siphon Project

This tour and briefing will provide the Environmental Services Commission and other meeting attendees with information about the Utilities Department's operations, maintenance and capital improvement project work in our water, sewer, and stormwater utilities.
