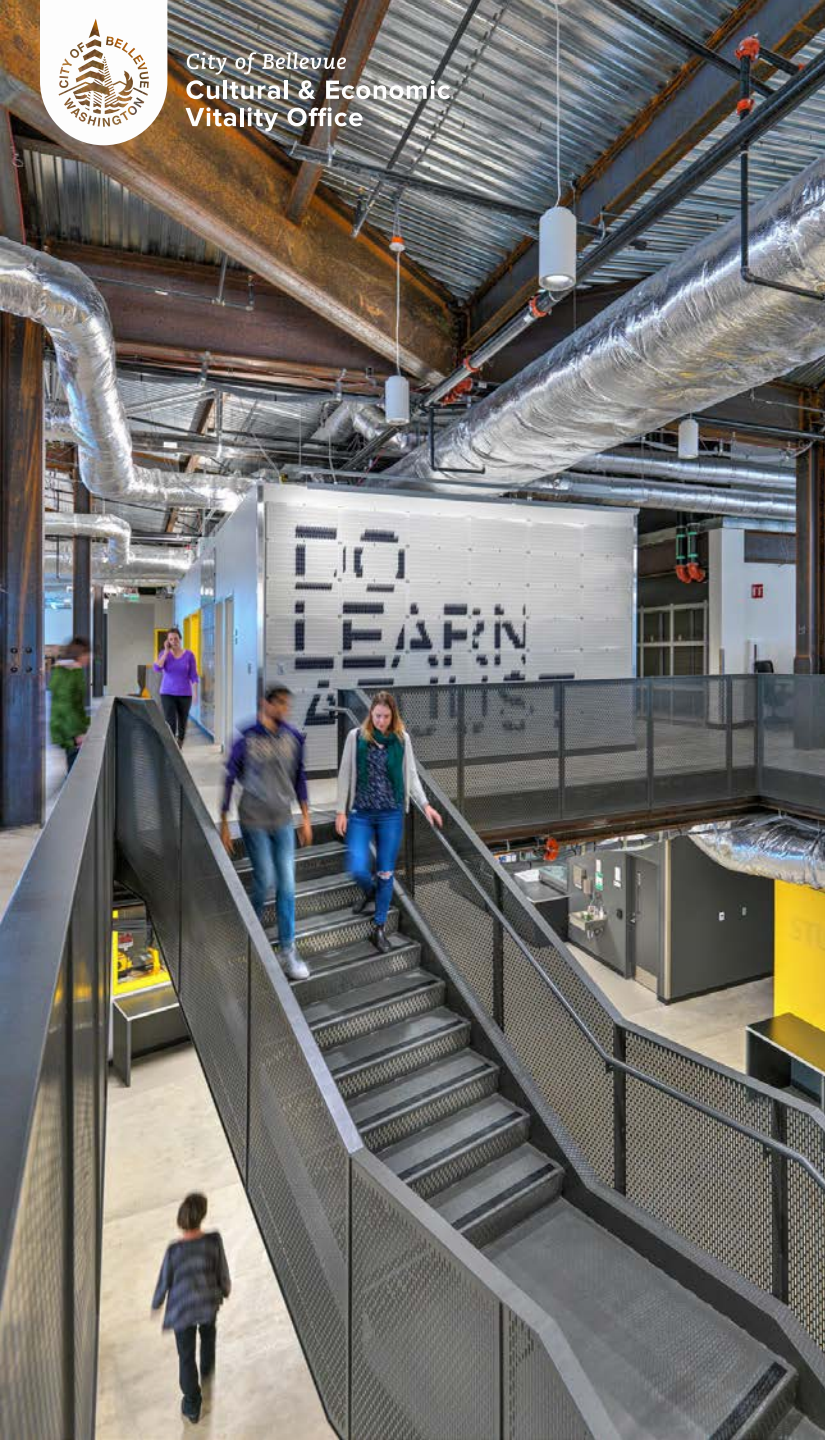

## Critical Deal Points

- Continues **coordinated recruitment** of new national and international tech firms
- **No new entity** is created; Cities' economic development staff will continue to operate
- Provides **a framework and formalization of the existing partnership**; does not add new work items or programs.

## Web Resources

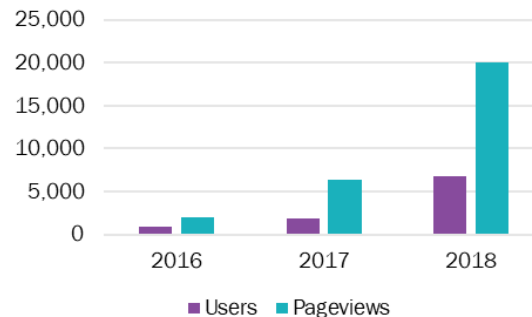
- Online “concierge” assistance and chatbot

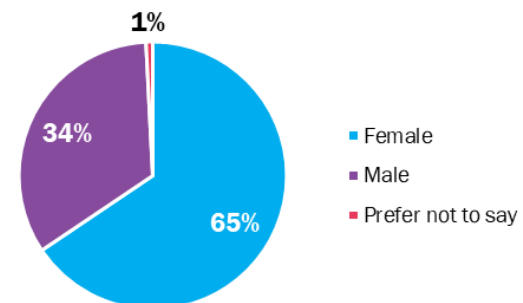
## 2019 Results & Highlights

- **Workshops held:** 56
- **Foundations registrations:** 1,317 (+64.6% YoY)
- **Unique registrants:** 493 (+54.1% YoY)
- **Contact list subscribers:** 782 (+30.3% YoY)
- **Capital Infusion:** \$1.3 million in 2018
- **Completed** LCY data gathering / strategic planning project in partnership with UW Bothell.

# Inter-Local Agreement (ILA)

## Critical Deal Points

- Continues **coordinated provision of services** to small businesses and entrepreneurs
- **No new entity** is created
- Cities' economic development staff will continue to operate, with Kirkland serving as managing partner
- Requires development of **long-range strategic plan**
- Bellevue, Issaquah, Redmond, and Renton will **contribute equally** to budget
