SUBJECT: Wrap-Around Services Program: 20 Year Anniversary

The Wrap-Around Services Program is an innovative partnership between the City of Bellevue and the Bellevue School District. Working collaboratively, the program aims to:

- Provide services that effectively meet the growing, diverse, and holistic needs
  of children, youth, and families that they serve.
- Involve the community in the life of the school through volunteer activities, family participation, and lifelong learning.
- Maximize the public's investment in local school facilities by making them available to the community for educational and recreational activities.
- Ensure that all kids and families are welcomed, included, and have the resources needed in order to be successful.

The program was started in 2005 and has now been supporting children and families in the Bellevue School District for 20 years. Over 20,000 students have benefited from the program; the program also impact family members and the wider community. Staff from the Parks & Community Services Department and the Bellevue School District will provide additional details on the program and its impact.
