Resolution authorizing execution of a five-year General Services Contract with Play-Well TEKnologies in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, plus all applicable taxes.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Resolution authorizes execution of a revenue-sharing General Services Contract with Play-Well TEKnologies to provide programs and day camps at Crossroads Community Center.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The primary purpose of offering STEM Technology day camps and programs during the summer and out of school time is to provide additional educational opportunities for children and youth in a recreational setting. These camps and programs enhance and strengthen the science, technology, engineering and math skills that elementary and middle school students are learning during the school year, and support year-round student learning. The STEM Technology summer day camps are offered weekly in July and August and fill consistently. An average of 16 - 24 youth are registered per camp.

Play-Well TEKnologies has been providing programs at Crossroads Community Center since 2014. Play-Well TEKnologies programs build problem-solving skills, provide opportunities for creative expression, foster a greater appreciation of how things work, and encourage the qualities of inquisitiveness, self-reliance, and self-confidence in children and youth. Play-Well TEKnologies does this in the context of fun filled engineering and architectural projects that both the youth and instructors enjoy.

The City of Bellevue issued a Request for Proposals in 2018 for STEM Technology programs and camps. Consistent with contracting policies, the City conducted an open and fair competitive process. Based on the evaluation of the proposals against the evaluation criteria, the selection panel recommended Play-Well TEKnologies as the preferred vendor to develop a contract for Council approval.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS

Policy Impact

Comprehensive Plan: Parks, Recreation & Open Space Element

PA-24 Collaborate with school districts and private and non-profit providers to deliver a coordinated array of recreation, athletic instruction, arts, gathering spaces and community services.

Bellevue City Code

BCC 4.28 provides for the fair and equitable treatment of all persons involved in the purchasing process. Council authorization is required for contracts that exceed \$90,000.

Fiscal Impact

This action would authorize execution of a revenue-sharing General Services Contract with Play-Well TEKnologies in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, plus all applicable taxes, to operate STEM Technology day camps and programs at Crossroads Community Center for a five-year period. Play-Well TEKnologies will operate the STEM Technology programs and camps and will be paid by the City 65 percent of all generated revenue, not to exceed \$250,000 over the five-year term. The City of Bellevue will retain 35 percent of the revenue. An example of what this revenue share will look like is provided below:

Sufficient appropriation exists in the 2019-2020 Parks & Community Services Department Operating Budget for the first two years of the agreement. Additional expenditure authority associated with this agreement will be requested in subsequent operating budgets and will be subject to final budget appropriation.
