economic vitality; and

Whereas: the transportation sector produces more greenhouse gas emissions than any other sector

of our economy, making the way we travel one of the most powerful tools we have in

addressing the climate crisis; and

Whereas: building bicycle-friendly communities enhances health, quality of life and neighborhood

connectivity while improving safety and reducing air pollution; and

Whereas: the City of Bellevue's Choose Your Way Bellevue program, alongside key community

partners, actively supports Bike Everywhere Month each May; and

Whereas: the City of Bellevue, in partnership with organizations like Eastrail Partners and King

County Parks, is working to expand safe, accessible bicycling options across our

community to create networks to support this affordable, inclusive mode of transportation

that helps to address social and transportation equity; and

Whereas: events like Bike Everywhere Day on May 14, 2025, encourage residents to experience

bicycling as a convenient, healthy and sustainable travel choice.
