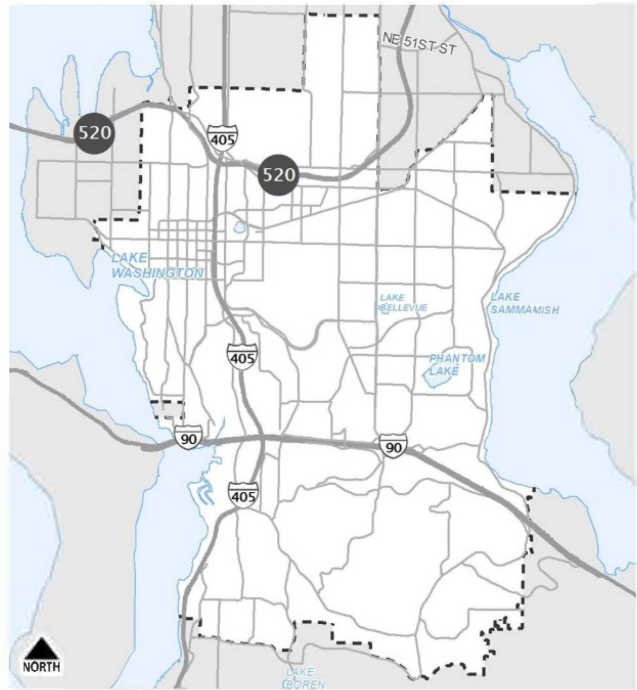


Vision Zero Rapid Build Data Driven Safety Program

Total Projected Cost

\$11.9M

In Bellevue 83% of fatal and serious injury traffic collisions occur on 8% of the City's total street network. This budget proposal funds the first phase of Vision Zero rapid build road safety projects along these High Injury Network (HIN) corridors. Based on a comprehensive review of citywide crash data, five major streets have been initially identified among the HIN corridors to advance in this proposal: NE 8th St east of downtown, Factoria Blvd, Bellevue Way south of downtown, Bel-Red Rd in the Overlake area, and 116th Ave NE in the Wilburton area. Funding will implement safety countermeasures such as radar feedback signs, pedestrian crossings, left turn pockets, restricted turn movements, medians, and other elements that produce improved safety outcomes. Staff will conduct before/after assessments of these projects to inform future safety investments and support Vision Zero performance monitoring.
