EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ACTION This Resolution amends Resolution No. 10336 to correct the name of the vendor for the purchase of two Utilities Water O&M trucks to NAFG and authorizes the execution of a purchase agreement with NAFG to replace two existing trucks that have reached the end of their useful life.

RECOMMENDATION

Move to adopt Resolution No. 10363.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On January 8, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 10336 authorizing the execution of a purchase agreement with Tri-Van Truck Body for the purchase of two replacement vehicles for the Utilities Department. The original agreement presented to Council incorrectly named Tri-Van Truck Body as the vendor. The correct vendor is NAFG, which employs the services of Tri-Van to complete specialty body builds on truck chassis for their clients.

Due to the relationship between Tri-Van and NAFG, Resolution No. 10336 is required to be amended to have NAFG as the party entering into a purchase agreement with the City. Under the amended resolution, this purchase will utilize an interlocal agreement between the City of Bellevue and the Sourcewell Contract. The City has benefitted from this purchasing arrangement for many years as it is a large consortium of public agencies and consequently obtains very competitive pricing.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS

Policy Impact

The proposed Ordinance would amend Resolution No. 10336 by changing the name of the vendor to National Auto Fleet Group.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
