## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 6792

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an agreement with Puget Sound Energy (PSE) to accept \$850,000 in funding from the PSE Climate Commitment Act Decarbonization Program to implement heat pump incentives for low-income households; amending the 2023-2024 budget of the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund to increase appropriation by \$850,000 in 2024; and authorizing expenditures of said funds.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or City Manager's designee is authorized to execute a one-year agreement with Puget Sound Energy (PSE) to accept \$850,000 in funding from the PSE Climate Commitment Act Decarbonization Program for Energy Smart Eastside to implement heat pump incentives for low-income households, a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or City Manager's designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have the authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.
