Staff seeks Transportation Commission final approval of Transportation Element and Downtown Subarea Plan policy recommendations in support of curb management.

## INFORMATION

### Curb Management Policy – Final Transportation Commission Recommendation

On April 28, the Transportation Commission reviewed and discussed staff recommendations for policy amendments to the Transportation Element and Downtown Subarea Plan that would augment the city's curb management practices and programs. Comments received resulted in a draft recommendation, which was discussed on May 12. At the May 12 meeting, Commission reviewed a refined set of policies, discussed considerations, and advised tweaks to policy language. Attachment A documents the status of policy recommendations as discussed by Transportation Commission.

At the Study Session on June 9, staff asks the Transportation Commission to approve preliminary Commission policy recommendations in Attachment A and to forward the policies to the Planning Commission for review in the context of the 2022 annual Comprehensive Plan Amendments.

## **NEXT STEPS**

Once policy recommendations are approved by Transportation Commission, the project team will bring recommendations to the Planning Commission to continue the policy amendment process.

Staff is preparing for a future Planning Commission Study Session planned for June 22, 2022. The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing later in 2022 to receive comment on all 2022 Comprehensive Plan Amendment recommendations.

To maintain project schedule, draft policies must be approved by the Transportation Commission at this meeting. Please contact myself or Kevin McDonald prior to the June 9 meeting if you have questions about policy recommendations.
