SUBJECT: Public Hearing: 2025-2029 CDBG Consolidated Plan and 2025 Action Plan

Background

The Commission will hold a public hearing on the 2025-2029 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Draft Consolidated Plan which includes the 2025 Draft Annual Action Plan and 2025 funding recommendations.

Every five years the City of Bellevue develops its CDBG Consolidated Plan which outlines the City's overarching priorities, goals, objectives and strategies that will guide the City's investments over the next five years and includes the Annual Action Plan. The Annual Action Plan guides the spending of its CDBG entitlement funds for the upcoming 2025 program year. The Consolidated Plan and subsequent Action Plans are the City's application for CDBG funding. The Draft five-year Consolidated Plan and the Draft Annual Action Plan are posted on the City website and made available for written public comment for 30 days as required by HUD. The final version of the 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan is completed after HUD determines and releases funding allocations for 2025.

The department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations requires the City to hold a public hearing as part of the Citizen Participation Plan on the development of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Consolidated Plan and each subsequent year for the development of the Annual Action Plan.

All interested persons will have an opportunity to comment to the Human Services Commission in person or virtually to provide feedback on the 2025-2029 Draft Consolidated Plan and 2025 funding recommendations.

Following the public hearing the Human Services Commission will vote to approve the 2025-2029 Draft Consolidated Plan.
