### A. Suggested Process:

Included in the Council Packet is Ordinance No. 6846, which contains the proposed Wilburton Vision Implementation Land Use Code Amendment (Wilburton LUCA). This Attachment B provides options in three topic areas that the Council may desire to use to amend Ordinance No. 6846. The three topic areas are:

- 1. Fee-in-Lieu Vesting;
- 2. Flexible Access Corridors; and
- 3. Upper-Level Stepback Incentive.

For each topic area, this attachment lays out potential amendment options. For each option, amendment language is provided as well as a brief explanation of the practical effect. Finally, for each option, suggested motion language is provided that the Council may choose to use to amend Ordinance No. 6846.

The Council may choose to pursue one or more of the options provided in this attachment or none of the options.

If the Council wants to pursue any of the options contained in this attachment, Council must first move to adopt Ordinance 6846. Once the main motion is on the floor for consideration, a Councilmember can then move to amend the Ordinance with one or more of the options provided in this attachment, should they choose to do so. After any pending amendments have been processed, the Council will then vote on the Ordinance, as amended.

### B. Background:

The Wilburton LUCA Ordinance incorporates Council-directed revisions made during the May 20 meeting. These revisions include:

- Removal of the local street map while retaining the cross-section as optional
- Reduction of the flexible corridor width
- Reduction of the open space requirement from 10% to 7%
- Allowance for off-site affordable housing performance for commercial development
- Allowance for initial phases of a Master Development Plan to proceed without requiring future phases to achieve proportional compliance, subject to certain conditions

## **C. Amendment Options:**

The language options below were prepared in response to Council's request for further discussion and direction on these topics. Suggested motion language is provided below, should the Council choose to amend LUCA Ordinance No. 6846 prior to taking final action.
