AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an Agreement with the Department of Commerce to accept \$1,500,000 in grant funding from the Home Electrification and Appliance Rebate (HEAR) Program for Energy Smart Eastside to implement heat pump incentives for adult family homes; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds contingent on an appropriation increase of \$1,500,000 in the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund through City Council approval of the 2025-2026 proposed budget.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or City Manager's designee is authorized to execute an Agreement with the Washington State Department of Commerce to accept \$1,500,000 in grant funding from the Home Electrification and Appliance Rebate (HEAR) Program for Energy Smart Eastside to implement heat pump incentives for adult family homes ("Commerce Grant Agreement"), a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. _______.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in the Commerce Grant Agreement within budget appropriation which shall be contingent on an appropriation increase of \$1,500,000 in the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund through City Council approval of the 2025-2026 proposed budget.

Section 3. The City Manager or City Manager's designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have the authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof, including agreements to expend funds consistent with the Commerce Grant Agreement.
