Senate Bill 5290

Introduced in early 2023

- Amends Local Project Review Act (RCW 36.70B)
- Land Use and environmental permits
- Goal to create efficiencies and streamline permitting
- Mandatory permit review timelines
- Penalties requiring refunding of fees

Signed by Governor May 8, 2023

- Effective summer 2023 and beyond
- Department of Commerce lead role

Senate Bill 5290

Key Components – Procedural and Administrative

- Prohibits site plan review on interior alterations
- Requires clear submittal requirements
- Amends definition of project permit
- Amends requirements for permit application completeness
- Publish performance reports at local and state level



Senate Bill 5290

Key Components – Policy Considerations

- Codify project permit shot clocks
 - 65 days when a public notice is <u>not</u> required
 - 100 days when a public notice is required
 - 170 days when public notice and public hearing required
- Fee refund penalty for not meeting shot clocks
 - ✓ Adopt 3 streamlining measures to avoid refunds
 - ✓ Included in preliminary budget for consideration

Permit Timelines

Findings

- Resource availability is a key component
- Special circumstances and complexity factors
- Alignment with current process improvement efforts

Previous Council Direction (June 11)

- Move 4 of 24 permit types to 170-day bucket:
 - Design Reviews
 - Master Development Plans
 - Critical Areas Land Use Permits
 - Shoreline Substantial Development Permits



Codifies Permit Timelines

- 65 days when a public notice is <u>not</u> required
- 100 days when a public notice is required, except for:
 - Design Reviews
 - Master Development Plans
 - Critical Areas Land Use Permits
 - Shoreline Substantial Development Permits
- 170 days when public notice and public hearing required, and adds 4 permit types above

Submittal Requirements and Completeness Check

- Notes that submittal requirements shall be posted online
- Clarifies when the review clock begins relative to 28-day completeness check

Definition: Nonresponsiveness

- Applicant is not showing measurable progress on revisions
- There is no ongoing communication regarding the applicant's ability or intent to provide requested information or make required corrections

DSD Director Rulemaking

Binding administrative rules about the codes DSD administers

- Updates to LUC 20.40.100 Administration of the Land Use Code
- Clarifies rulemaking authority and outlines when and how the Director may establish rules
- Details procedures, including:
 - Replacing public hearing requirement with an extended notice period and more enhanced noticing requirements
 - Establishing when a project may vest to a rule and how a rule may be appealed

Director Rule Examples

- Clarifying implementation of green building incentives
- Detailing single-family FAR calculation
- Explaining building height determination on sloped sites based on building segments
