ORDINANCE NO. 6791

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Commerce to accept \$3,151,090 in grant funding from the Home Electrification and Appliance Rebate (HEAR) Program for Energy Smart Eastside to implement heat pump incentives; amending the 2023-2024 budget of the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund to increase appropriation by \$250,000 in 2024 with the remaining \$2,901,090 to be appropriated in the 2025-2026 budget; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or City Manager's designee is authorized to execute an Interagency Agreement with the Washington State Department of Commerce to accept \$3,151,090 in grant funding from the Home Electrification and Appliance Rebate (HEAR) Program for Energy Smart Eastside to implement heat pump incentives, a copy of which Interagency Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. ______.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interagency Agreement within budget appropriation.

Section 3. The City Manger or City Manager's designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have the authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof, including agreements to expend funds consistent with the Interagency Agreement.
