NEP is a program available to all residents living in households in the City of Bellevue which includes single family, condominium, apartment, or affordable housing units. NEP is a conduit for the city to better understand the community's needs and help direct projects that may be out of scope for NEP funding to other City budgets for possible implementation. NEP projects must benefit the general public; be located on public property; not exceed the Neighborhood Area budget; be consistent with City plans and departmental policies; be designed and constructed within 3-5 years; and be maintainable by the City. NEP project examples suggested and chosen by Bellevue residents include artistic lighting in Lattawood Park, bat houses in the Lake Hills Greenbelt and a bee exhibit at Kelsey Creek Park. This proposal is for the continuation of a program that was founded in 1988 and moving forward with its next 7-year CIP cycle beginning in 2030.
