CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. <u>6859</u>

AN ORDINANCE to 1) authorize execution of an Agreement with Puget Sound Energy (PSE) to accept \$400,000 in grant funding from the PSE Decarbonization Program for Energy Smart Eastside (ESE) to implement heat pump incentives for income-qualified households; 2) amend the 2025-2026 budget of the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund to increase the appropriation by \$400,000; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute an agreement
with Puget Sound Energy (PSE) to accept \$400,000 in grant funding from the PSE
Decarbonization Program for Energy Smart Eastside (ESE) to implement heat pump
incentives for income-qualified households, a copy of which agreement shall be
substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 3. The City manager or designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said Grant Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regards the use thereof.

Section 4. At the time of execution of said Grant Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said grant monies is:

Puget Sound Energy (PSE) \$400,000

Section 6. Upon execution of said Grant Agreement, the budget for the 2025-2026 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserve Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$400,000 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
