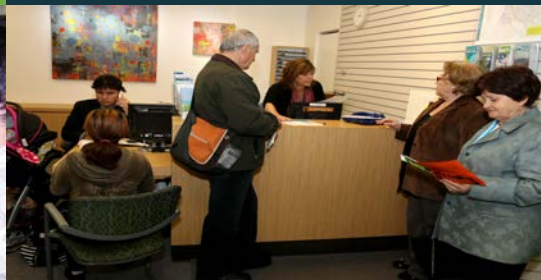

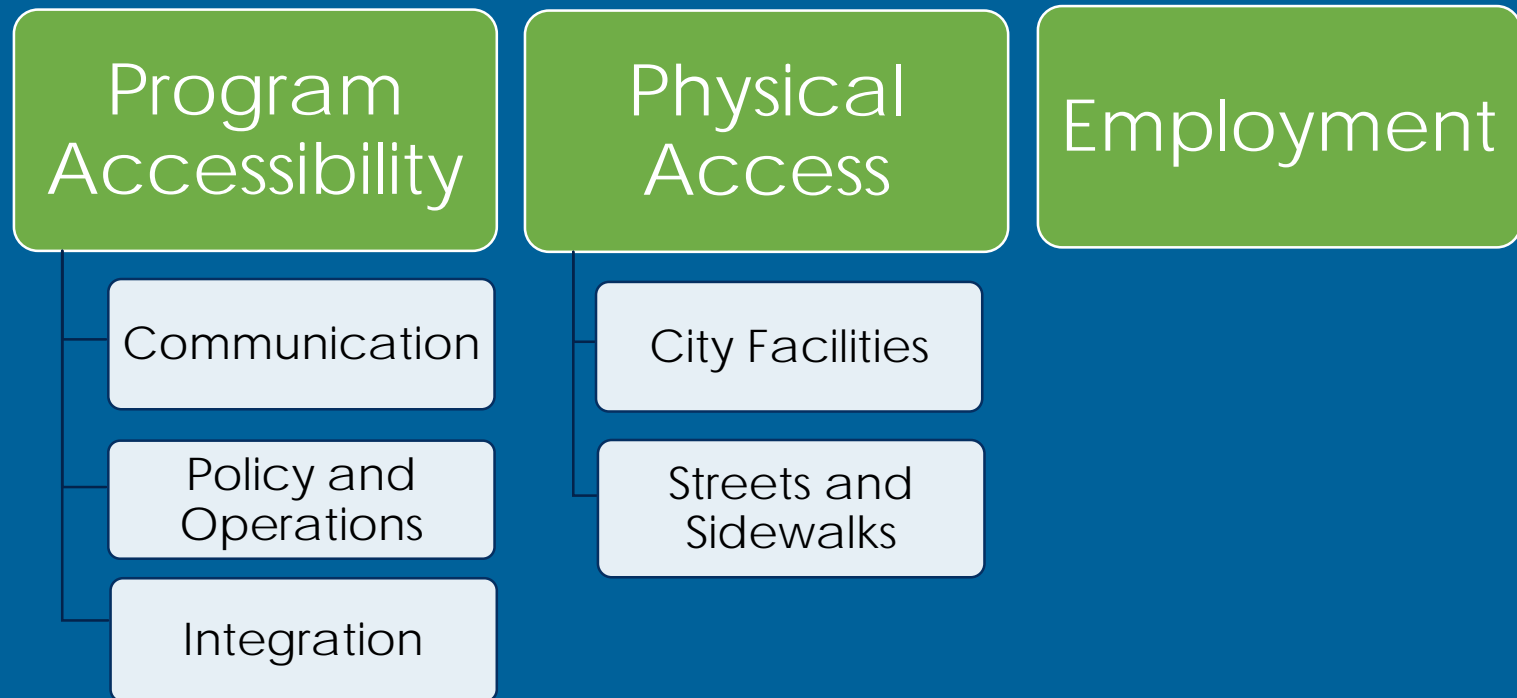

- Review by the City Attorney's Office

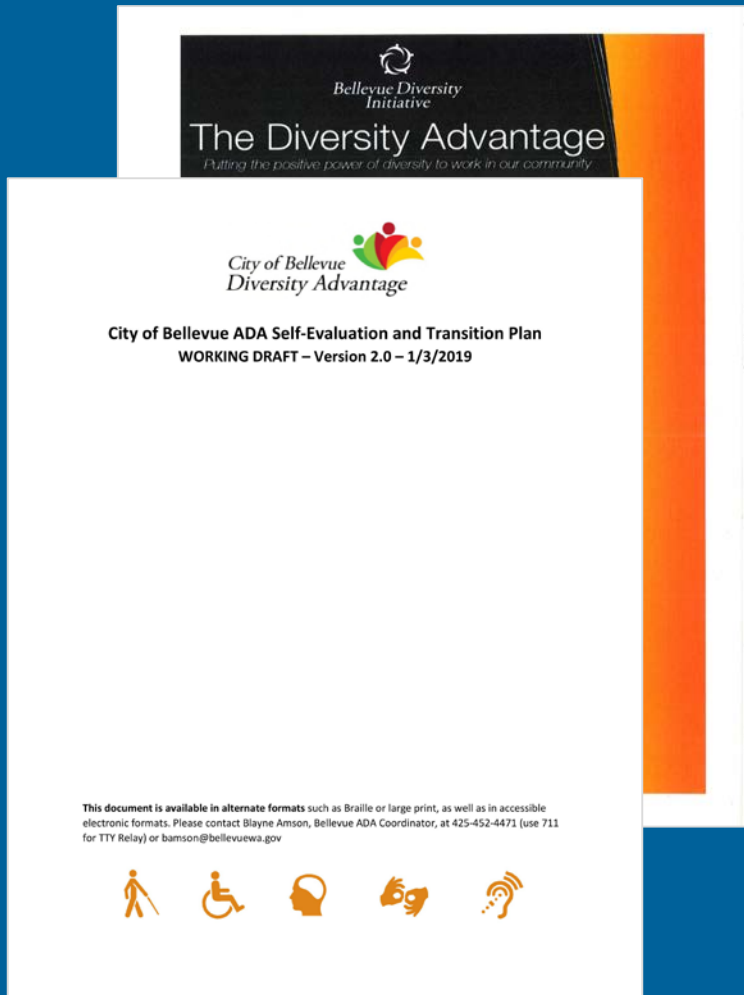


PLAN UPDATE: EXTERNAL PROCESS

- Focus groups
- Online questionnaires
- In-person questionnaires at community centers and public-facing sites
- Collaboration with several non-profits and disability rights groups to support in outreach



TRANSITION PLAN RECOMMENDATIONS



- Recommendations are largely compliance-based
- Reflective of the Diversity Advantage Initiative
- Have a broad reach demonstrating the City's commitment to compliance and inclusion.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS

- Interdepartmental collaboration has included consideration of impact
- Departments have already begun adaption of program budgets and policy
- For decades highly impacted departments have considered budgetary needs of maintaining ADA compliance
