- 5 new sidewalk cafés citywide with 45 seats, plus 5 pending
- 5 new Main Street on-street dining spaces with +40 seats

- Increase confidence among key audiences to re-emerge and reengage in our safe, healthy communities.














- Campaign designed to connect and promote local businesses in Downtown Bellevue.

Small Business Support

- 4,087 PPP loans to Bellevue businesses
- 9 Bellevue businesses received the State Working Washington Grant (more funding anticipated)
- Over 200 businesses have applied for Bellevue's business relief grant.
- 471 businesses assisted through BINW partnership (119 Bellevue)
