who enjoy the city's numerous lakes, rivers and waterways; and

Whereas: National Safe Boating Week, observed from May 17 - May 23, 2025, serves as

the official launch of the year-round Safe Boating Campaign; and

Whereas: National Safe Boating Week is observed to bring attention to important lifesaving

tips for recreational boaters so they can have a safer, more fun experience out

on the water throughout the year; and

Whereas: the Safe Boating Campaign, including initiatives like "Wear Your Life Jacket at

Work" Day on May 16, 2025, aims to promote the value of voluntary, consistent

life jacket wear by recreational boaters; and

Whereas: in Washington State, paddlers represent a significant portion of recreational

boating fatalities, highlighting the need for increased awareness and education

on paddling safety; and

Whereas: the City of Bellevue recognizes the importance of boating and paddling safety

and supports efforts to educate the public on best practices to prevent accidents and save lives, including promoting the use of life jacket loaner stations where individuals can borrow properly fitted life jackets - at no charge - to help increase

life jacket use and raise awareness about their life-saving importance.

Now, therefore, I, Lynne Robinson, Mayor of the City of Bellevue, Washington, and on behalf of its City Council, do hereby proclaim **May 17 - May 23, 2025,** as:

National Safe Boating and Paddling Week
