Background

- Efforts made in 2018 to gather community feedback to inform the city's ADA Self-evaluation and Transition Plan.
- This plan was taken to Council where the question was asked, "What was feedback we heard that was a great idea but did not make it into the plan?"
- Accessible changing tables for children and adults.
- Acting on feedback from the public related to changing tables being installed in the restrooms at the Inspiration Playground at Downtown Park.
- Staff from Parks and Community Services worked with the Intergovernmental Relations Office to secure funding during the 2020 legislative session.



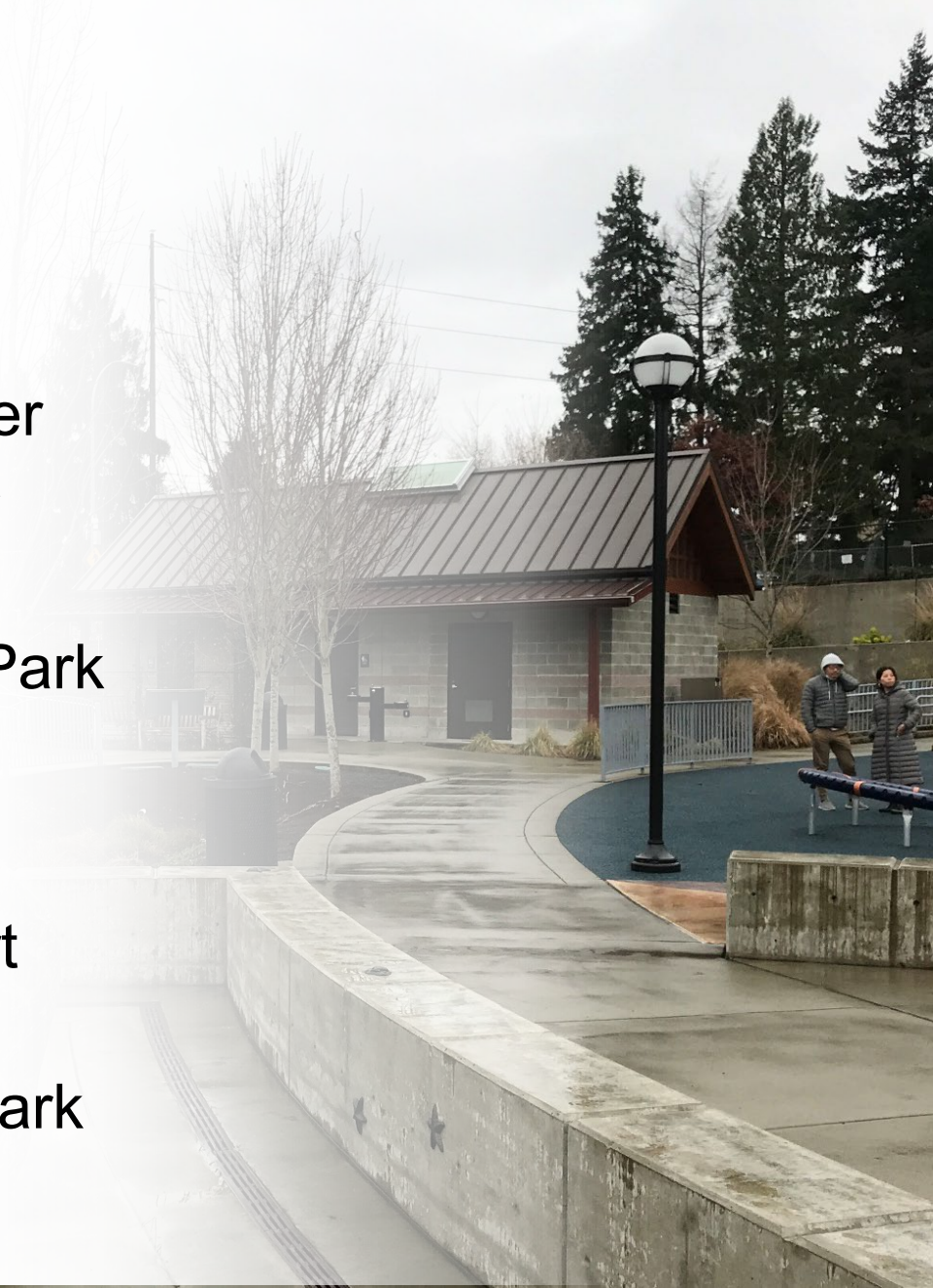
Project Scope

- \$97,000 granted
- Eight Parks and Community Services sites chosen
- 13 tables to be installed and maintained
- Completion date for the installation of tables expected in early 2023
