4.32.070 Sale or disposition of real property of any value or personal property ~~or equipment~~ in excess of \$50,000, originally acquired for public utility purposes.

Whenever the city shall determine, by council resolution, that any ~~lands~~ real property originally acquired for public utility purposes, or any personal property with an estimated value greater than fifty thousand dollars and ~~or equipment~~ originally acquired for public utility purposes, is surplus to the city's needs and is not required for providing continued public utility service, then the council by resolution and after a public hearing may cause such ~~lands,~~ property ~~or equipment~~ to be sold, leased, or conveyed. Such resolution shall state the fair market value and ~~such~~ other terms and conditions for such disposition as the council deems to be in the best public interest ~~(RCW 35.94.040)~~.
