## Strike Draft - BCC 4.32.070

4.32.070 Sale or disposition of real <u>property of any value</u> or personal property <u>or equipmentin</u> excess of \$50,000, originally acquired for public utility purposes.

Whenever the city shall determine, by council resolution, that any landsreal property originally acquired for public utility purposes, or any personal property with an estimated value greater than fifty thousand dollars and or equipment originally acquired for public utility purposes, is surplus to the city's needs and is not required for providing continued public utility service, then the council by resolution and after a public hearing may cause such lands, property or equipment to be sold, leased, or conveyed. Such resolution shall state the fair market value and such other terms and conditions for such disposition as the council deems to be in the best public interest (RCW 35.94.040).
