## ORDINANCE NO. 6706

AN ORDINANCE (1) accepting \$115,000 from the Bellevue Police Foundation to support recruiting efforts; (2) amending Ordinance 6698, adopted November 21, 2022, as previously amended, to increase the appropriation to the 2023-2024 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund in the amount of \$115,000; (3) appropriating the unanticipated grant revenues to that fund; and (4) authorizing expenditures of said grant funds for recruiting services.

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to accept \$115,00 from the Bellevue Police Foundation to support recruiting efforts.

Section 2. Ordinance 6698, adopted November 21, 2022, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to the 2023-2024 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund in the amount of \$115,000.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received shall be more or less than the anticipated amount, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive said funds and to expend the same for recruiting services and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.
