
Portable Art Collection

Update: The 2024 acquisitions will be displayed at City Hall from June through the end of the year, and a reception will likely take place in July.

Temporary Public Art Projects*

Updates: An artist has been selected to create original artwork for a series of art panels along 124th Ave, NE in the BelRed Arts District. Bethany Fackrell will create nine images that respond to the theme of nature and water, which will be installed as vinyl wraps on metal panels.

A set of utility boxes has been wrapped with a design created by artist Eileen Jimenez at the northwest corner of the intersection of 136th Place and NE 20th in BelRed.



Public Art Collection & Maintenance
