EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ACTION

This Resolution authorizes execution of all documents necessary to implement settlement of the claim brought by Sergei Dreizin in the amount of \$132,248.88.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

On February 23, 2023 City of Bellevue Utilities responded to a sewage backup at the Dreizin residence at 4436 95th Ave NE, Yarrow Point. Sewage backed up through the basement floor and shower drain spreading to the sauna, movie room, work out area, and remaining basement area. Upon investigation, Utilities determined the City should accept responsibility. As verified by Evergreen Adjustment Services, the property sustained damage to its flooring, plumbing, drywall, millwork, and finishes. The settlement amount is to cover costs for mitigation and reconstruction of these damaged components.

POLICY & FISCAL IMPACTS

Policy Impact

Pursuant to Bellevue City Code 4.36.030, settlement and payment of claims exceeding \$75,000 requires the authorization of City Council.

Fiscal Impact

This Resolution will authorize the execution of all documents necessary to implement settlement of the claim brought by Sergei Dreizin in the amount of \$132,248.88. Sufficient funds for this claim exist within the City's 2023-2024 General Self-Insurance Fund budget.
