ORDINANCE NO. 6900

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of Amendment 8 and supplements, if necessary, to the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with King County for Conservation Futures program, providing the city with \$3,487,244 for the completed property acquisition in the Coal Creek/Lakemont neighborhood along with \$105,000 for site stabilization costs, and \$4,422,630 for the completed acquisition of properties in the Lake Sammamish neighborhood, 2) amending the 2025-2030 General Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Fund to increase the appropriation by \$105,000, and 3) amending the 2025-2030 General CIP Plan to increase the budget by \$105,000 for Parks & Open Space Acquisition (CIP Plan No. P-AD-82).

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute Amendment 8 and supplements, if necessary, to the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with King County for Conservation Futures program, providing the city with \$3,487,244 for the completed property acquisition in the Coal Creek/Lakemont neighborhood along with \$105,000 for site stabilization costs, and \$4,422,630 for the completed acquisition of properties in the Lake Sammamish neighborhood, a copy of which amendment shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said amended Interlocal Cooperation Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee shall have the responsibility for the administration of said monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The 2025-2026 General Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Fund adopted by Ordinance No. 6822 on November 19, 2024, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation by \$105,000.

Section 5. The 2025-2030 General CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 6822 on November 19, 2024, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the budget by \$105,000 for Parks & Open Space Acquisition (CIP Plan No.

P-AD-82).

Section 6. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said amended Interlocal Cooperation Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
