## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 6777

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a grant agreement with the Department of Commerce to accept \$1,000,000 in reimbursable grant funding from the Clean Energy Fund Building Electrification Program for Energy Smart Eastside to implement heat pump incentives for low- and moderate-income households; amending the 2023-2024 Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserve Fund to increase the appropriation by \$1,000,000 in 2024.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement with the Department of Commerce to accept \$1,000,000 in reimbursable grant funding from the Clean Energy Fund Building Electrification Program for Energy Smart Eastside to implement heat pump incentives for low- and moderate-income households, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive and expend monies as authorized in said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 6764, adopted on November 20, 2023, and previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the 2023-2024 budget, by increasing appropriations to the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund by \$ 1,000,000 in anticipated grant funds from the Department of Commerce.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
