

Budget Process Timeline

April 30	Proposals due internally
Through Summer	Proposal review and scenarios developed
September	City Managers Preliminary Budget Proposal
June- October	Public Hearings
October	Council Deliberation
November	Council Budget Adoption

- CIP phases: Planning, Design, Construction/implementation
- Need performance measures per proposal
