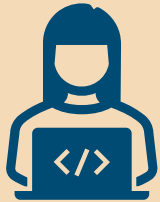


Background: Council Vision

Digital Equity Device Distribution

- **Pilot** program
- **Partnership** with PCs for People and Mini City Hall
- In person application & **distribution event** in early April



Device Distribution Details

- **60 device kits** for income-eligible Bellevue residents
- Includes **technical support**, and **connectivity** for a year
- City of Bellevue will **survey** recipients at 3 and 6 months



Opportunities to Expand

- Learn from pilot process
- Service clearly in demand
- Expect to learn more from participant surveys
- Second round later in 2026
