SUBJECT: Data and Technology Accomplishments

Staff will provide a brief presentation about work toward High Performance Government priorities, highlighting ways the City has advanced work in data analytics. This Council Priority seeks to leverage data and technology to enhance community engagement, equity and accountability.

Progress toward this council priority includes:

- Share Interactive Reports: Bellevue has continued to leverage data to report on key indicators to better understand city services and performance. Among these accomplishments include: the Business Survey and Performance Dashboard, a tool to assess the health of Bellevue's economy and inform policy and programming, the Environmental Performance Dashboard, a website that shares information about the city's progress towards its environmental sustainability goals, and the Bellevue Performance Website, a place where the city shares data regarding performance and key performance indicators.
- Reporting Community Data: Projects include the launch of a Police Transparency dashboard, State of the Neighborhoods website, and the start of the Bellevue Equity Atlas project. In addition, the city launched an internal Data Hub pilot to serve as a foundational piece to support future data analytics.
- Council Priorities Dashboard: The launch of Bellevue's Council Priorities
 Dashboard in July 2022 provided a transparent way for the Council and the
 public to check on the progress of the Council's vision and priorities.

Work toward this priority continues and staff expect to update the Council Priorities dashboard in November with refreshed key performance and community indicators. In addition, the upcoming Bellevue Equity Index Project dashboard aims to provide information to assist the city in prioritizing projects with an equity lens.

Lastly, the Center for Digital Government awarded Bellevue second place in their annual Digital Cities Survey on November 9. This prestigious award looks at digital services

across the entire city, with several areas focusing on data and analytics work specifically. Bellevue is honored to have placed in the top three for more than 5 years.
