- All nine executive office positions retained by Democrats
- Democrats retained, expanded majorities
  - Democrats can approve bonds and transfers out of the budget stabilization account without Republican support
- Significant turnover
- Some new leadership, new committee chairs, ranking members, committee members




#### 2025 Legislative Session Preview

- Consider and adopt policy



#### Governance & Fiscal Sustainability

- Bellevue requests that the Legislature support cities in managing public works needs in
- Cities must not be burdened by state mandates that are unaccompanied by sufficient funding or
- The city strongly opposes proposals that would undermine the ability for cities to administer local the dry survingly upposes proposed that would underthine the ability for three to administer rock business and occupation (B&O) tax revenues. Diminished local authority reduces flexibility to tailor tax to local conditions and may reduce revenues that fund critical services. Believue supports revising the one percent cap on annual property tax levy growth with a limit
- Bellevue supports preserving and enhancing state-shared revenues and retaining programs to meet the diverse needs of local government. The city requests that the State provide greater flexibility for local revenue decisions.
- Believue supports proposals that increase operational efficiency while maintaining transparency and access to open government, including updating the Public Records Act and the Open Public Meetings Act to reduce costs to cities and disruptions during public meetings.
- Support cities in managing public works needs in the most efficient manner possible, including flexible and reasonable contracting and procurement requirements.
- Innovations like edge computing and generative


