EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ACTION

This Ordinance appoints Diane Carlson as City Manager and authorizes execution of an agreement establishing the City Manager's terms and conditions of employment.

RECOMMENDATION

Move to adopt Ordinance No. 6813

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

After a consultant received input from the City Council, City Leadership Team, and community members about the desired qualifications and requirements for the vacant City Manager position, a job profile was created. After reviewing of the job profile and receiving input from the consultant, Council decided to interview the Acting City Manager, Diane Carlson, for the position. The City held two public forums for the Acting City Manager to respond to questions submitted in advance by the public. The Council then interviewed Diane Carlson for the position of City Manager at a special public meeting.

At the September 17, 2024 meeting, Council unanimously selected Diane Carlson as the next City Manager and directed staff to begin negotiations for an employment contract to be brought back along with an ordinance formally appointing Diane Carlson to the position of City Manager.
