






#### 2023 Available Funds

- Initial \$4.0 million available
  - \$1.4 million from Bellevue
- Additional \$2.1 million committed by the City of Redmond
- \$6.1 million in awards
- Funding Sources:
  - Local General Funds
  - HB 1406 sales tax funds
  - Loan Repayments


#### **ARCH City Funding Proportions, Fall 2023**






