
Neighborhood Traffic Safety Program

This program supports the Council's vision of implementing projects in neighborhoods that focus on safety and connectivity with an emphasis on traffic calming. This proposal funds design and construction of neighborhood traffic calming/safety improvements (e.g., speed humps, traffic circles, radar signs, turn restrictions, etc.) that change driver behavior and reduce excessive vehicle speeds, discourage motorists from cutting through neighborhoods and enhance pedestrian/bicycle safety. It also funds educational programs to encourage safe driving and best practices for staying safe walking and biking. Project locations are identified by community members and there has been an increased number of requests for solutions to traffic safety issues in neighborhoods. Projects are funded to address the critical issues at prioritized locations and support citywide initiatives such as Vision Zero.


