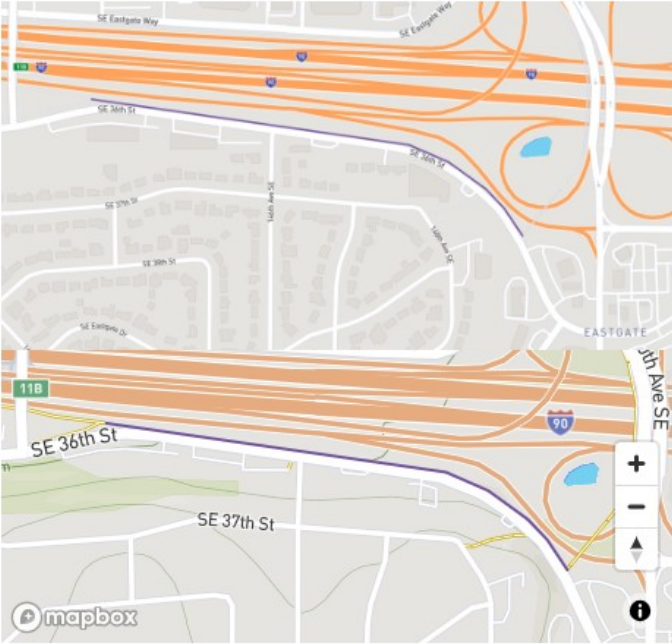


Mountains to Sound Greenway Trail - 142nd PI SE to 150th Ave SE

This proposal will fund the construction of the third phase of the Mountains to Sound Greenway Trail from 142nd Place SE to the pedestrian overcrossing of Interstate 90 (I-90) at 150th Avenue SE. The trail design includes a separated, at grade, 12-foot-wide paved trail running along I-90 and SE 36th Street with trailhead treatments, a new mid-block crosswalk with RRFB at 146 Ave SE and SE 36 St, upgrades to the existing crosswalk at SE 36 St and the I-90 pedestrian overcrossing, walls, urban design elements, landscaping, lighting, storm drainage improvements and natural drainage practices where feasible. The trail will provide access to the local street network. The City has secured a federal grant and a State Move Ahead Washington funding award to fund 8.97 million dollars of the project. Additional funding will be needed to construct the project.
