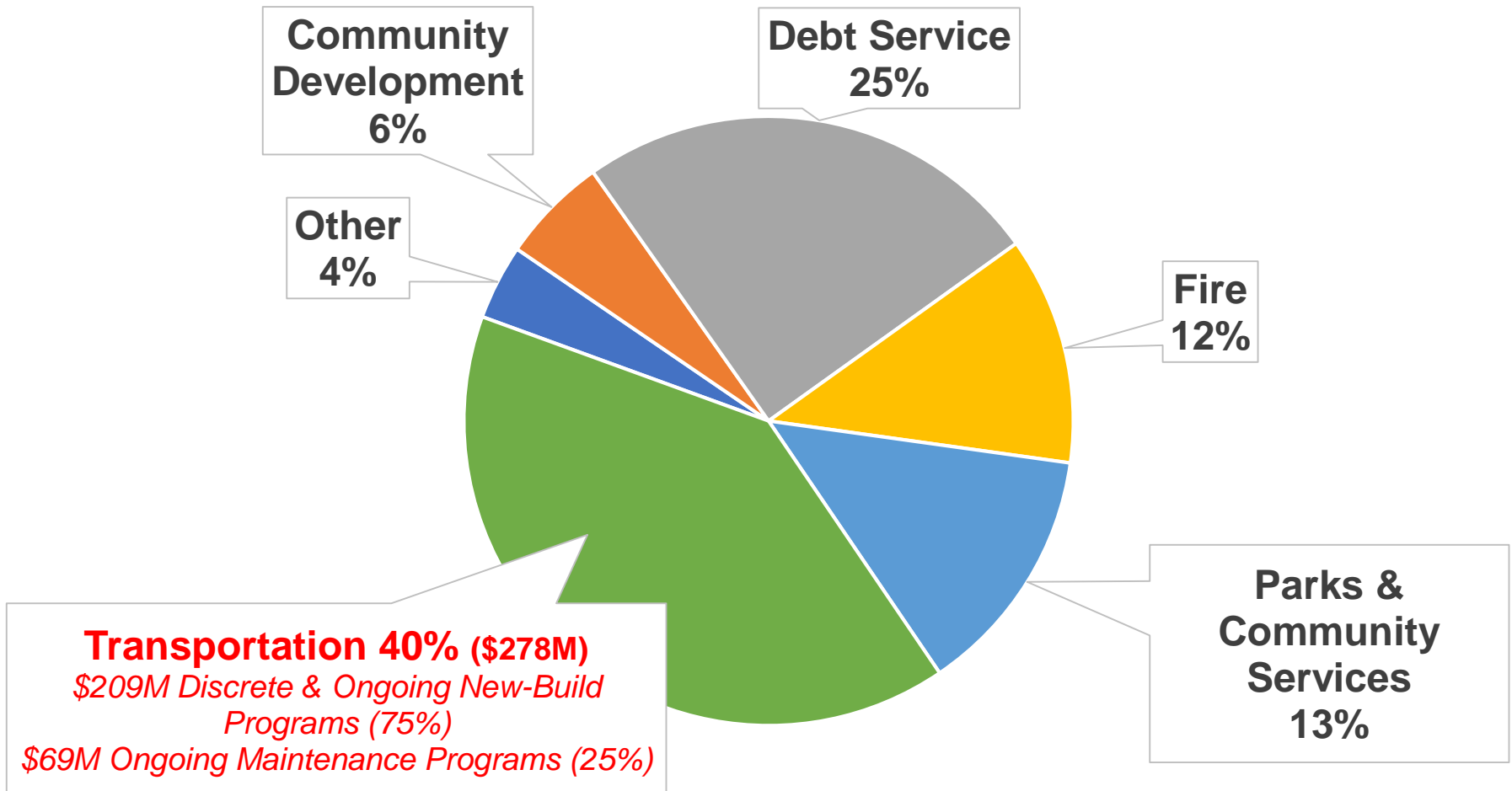

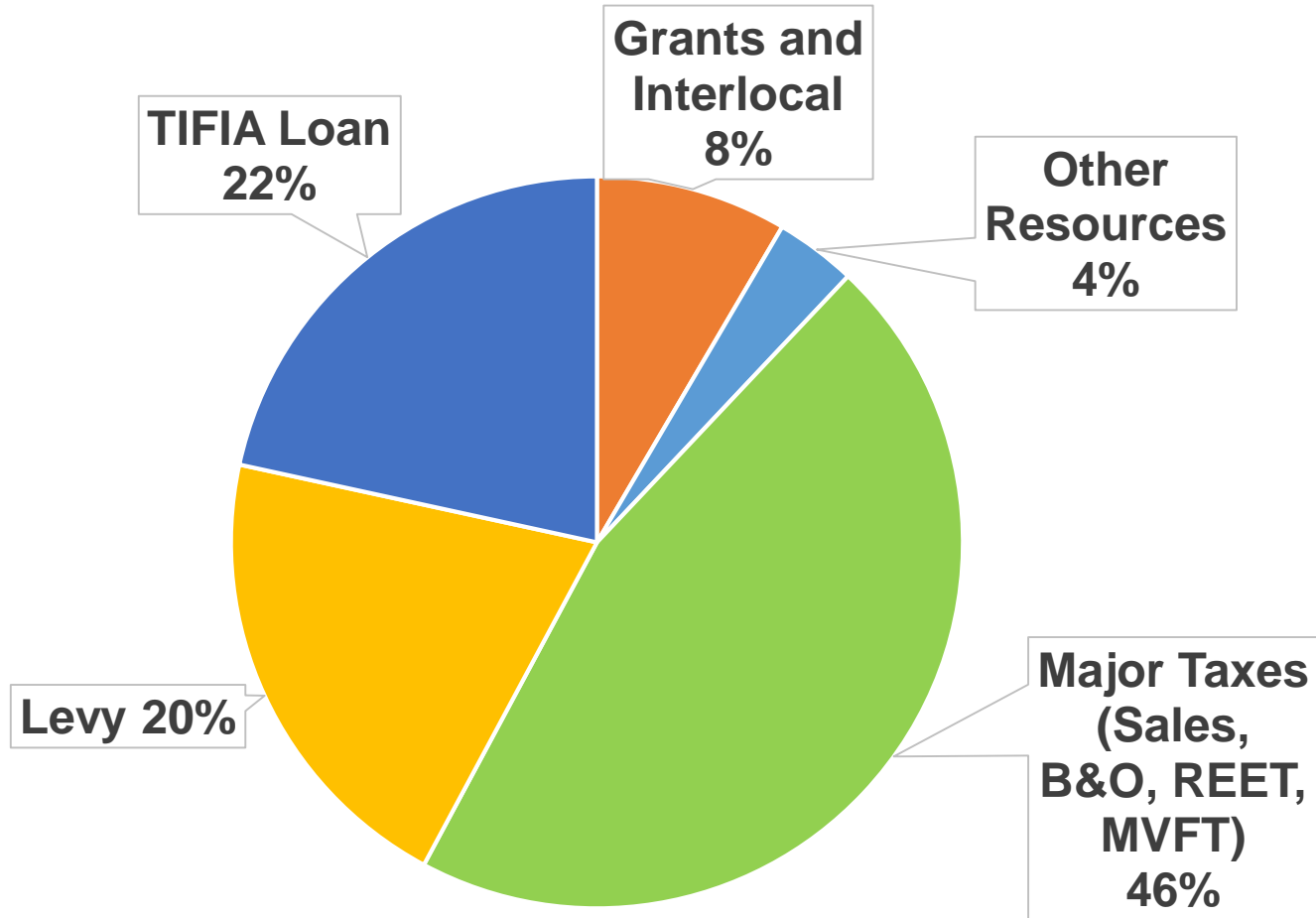

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

124th Avenue NE Corridor Improvements: NE Spring Blvd to Ichigo Way

Description and benefits
As part of the 124th Avenue Corridor Improvement Project to support planned growth and development in the BelRed area, improve circulation and accommodate an East Link light rail undercrossing, the City of Bellevue plans to:

- Widen 124th Avenue NE from NE Spring Boulevard to Ichigo Way (formerly NE 18th Street) to five lanes.
- Raise the roadway to build a bridge on 124th Avenue NE to allow for the East Link light rail vehicles to pass underneath.
- Install sidewalk with planters on the east side and a portion of the sidewalk on the west side of 124th Avenue NE.
- Install a traffic signal at the intersection of 124th Avenue NE and the future NE 16th Street.

This is the first phase of a three-phased corridor improvement project. The City awarded a construction contract to Inwest Construction Inc. to complete this first phase of work.

What to expect
In early August, the city's contractor will begin survey work, traffic control set up and install erosion control in preparation of more heavy construction activities. **ROAD CLOSURE SEPTEMBER 2019 - JUNE 2020**
In order to build the bridge, a portion of 124th Avenue NE between NE 12th Street/BelRed Road and Northup Way will be closed to through traffic. Access to businesses along 124th Avenue NE will be maintained during the closure from either direction. Detour routes will be available via 120th, 130th or 132nd avenues northeast; the truck detour route will be on 120th Avenue NE. See the detour map on the reverse side.

CONTINUED CONSTRUCTION THROUGH 2020
Following completion of the bridge, single lane closures on 124th Avenue NE between NE Spring Boulevard and Ichigo Way will be needed to complete the remaining work: a new sidewalk, retaining walls, stormwater facilities, landscaping, painting, underground utilities, traffic signals and street lights. Project completion is anticipated in late 2020 but the construction schedule is subject to change.



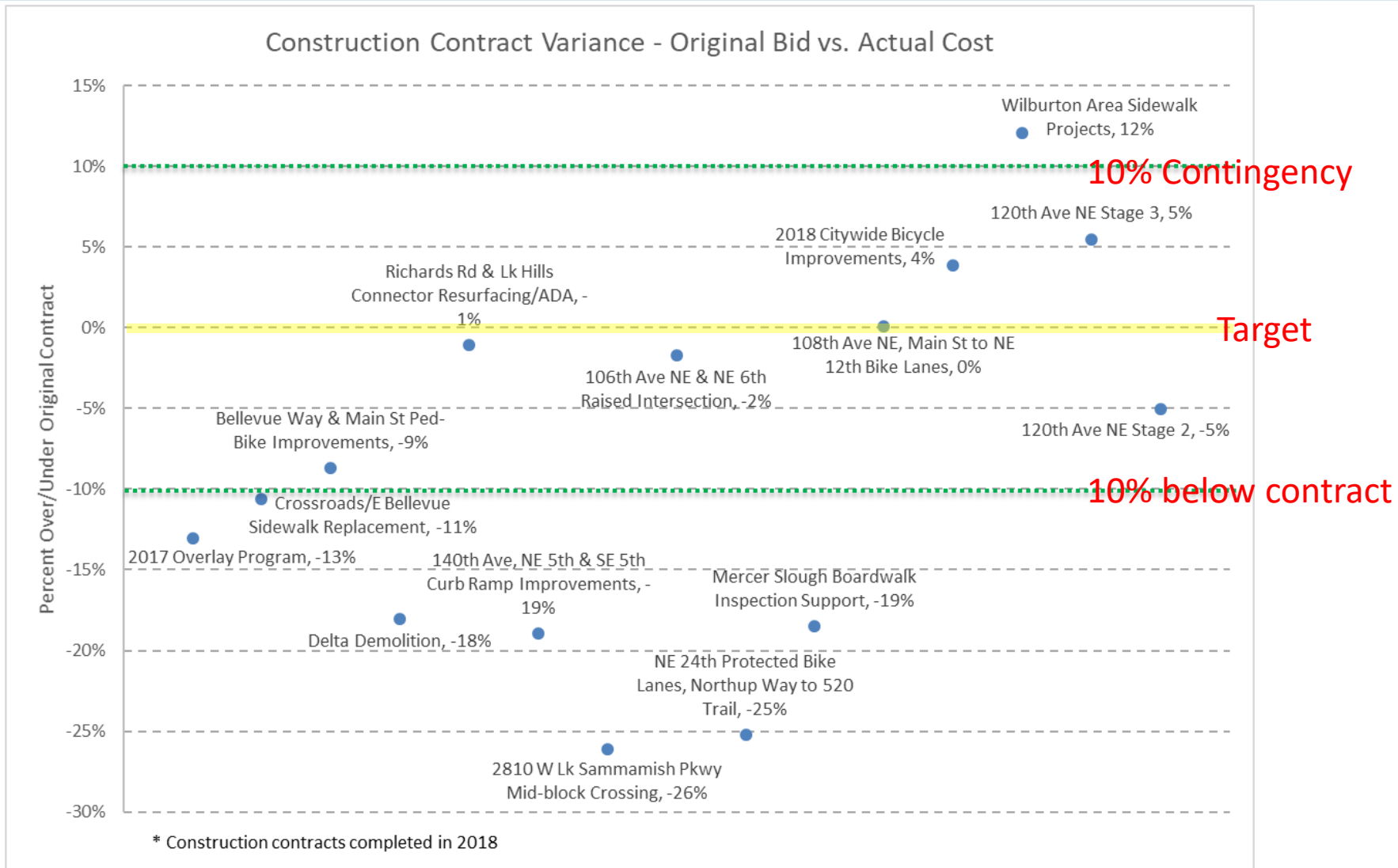

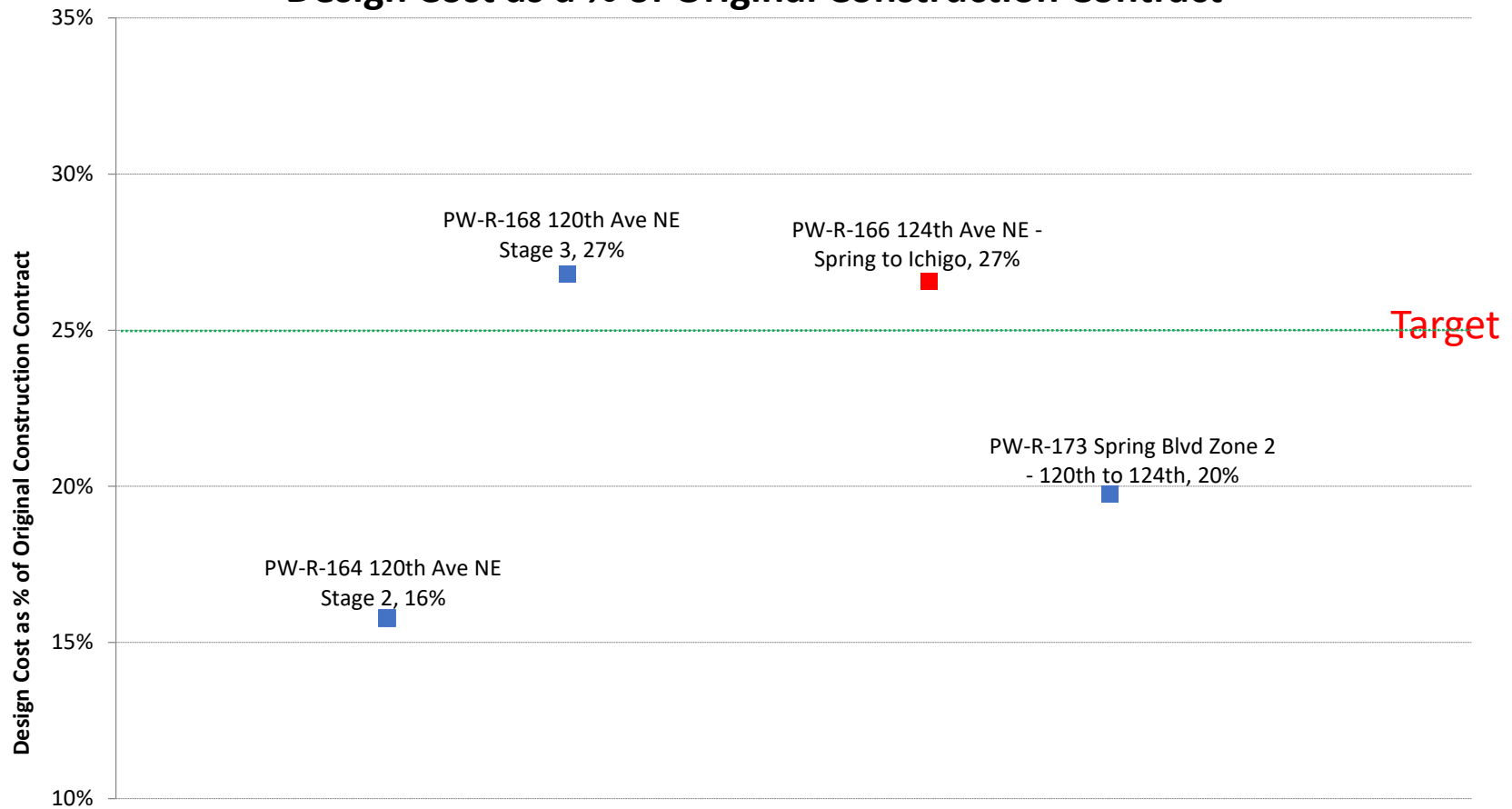

Project Issues

- 150th Avenue SE Wall Replacement
 - Required more and larger blocks to meet seismic needs
 - Reimbursed by the County
- Mountains to Sound Greenway Grant - easternmost section
 - Recommend returning grant funds due to inability to fund project construction under required timeline

Transportation CIP



New Grant Information:

- Mountains to Sound Greenway Trail – two new grants to help get to 142nd Avenue SE:
 - \$2.7M federal funds through PSRC
 - \$1M Sound Transit Board – System Access Fund
- 148th Avenue SE Preservation (Overlay) Award of \$1.4M through PSRC
- 124th Avenue SE TIB Application – awards announced Nov

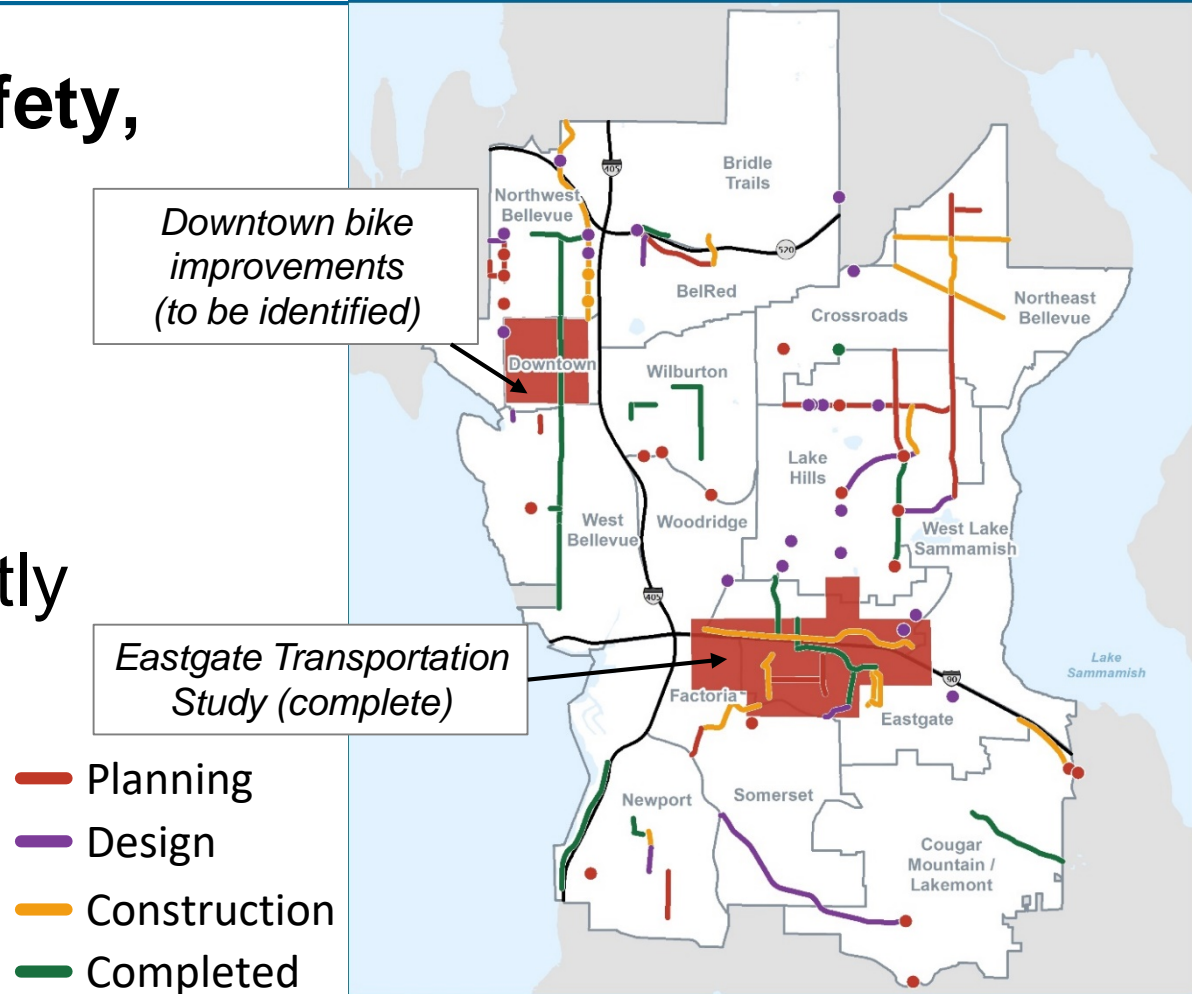
