Proposition 1: City of Bellevue Levy for Parks & Open Space November 8, 2022 Ballot Proposition

A new funding measure will go before voters to increase investments in Bellevue's parks and open space system. After considering public input and an updated Parks & Open Space System Plan, Bellevue City Council approved the measure for the November 8 ballot.

The Parks & Open Space Levy The ballot proposition includes funding to enhance and maintain Bellevue's parks and open space system. If approved, the package would accomplish the following:

Preserve open space, greenways and wildlife corridors;

- Develop trails, community parks and neighborhood parks;
- Invest in emerging sports opportunities, off-leash areas and recreation;
- Plan major community facilities like aquatics and a cross-cultural center; Restore and develop waterfront parks and protect water quality in Bellevue's lakes and
- Acquire and develop parks and open space in the Bel-Red and Wilburton areas; and
- Maintain improvements consistent with Bellevue Parks' standards.





Fee Reduction Program

Eligible projects:

- 100% affordable housing projects at or below 80% AMI
- Permanent supportive housing projects
- Emergency housing projects
- Homeless services uses
- Must be affordable for life of project

Amount of reduction:

- 100% of review and inspection fees
- Does not include pass-through fees
- Cap on pre-development services fee reduction
