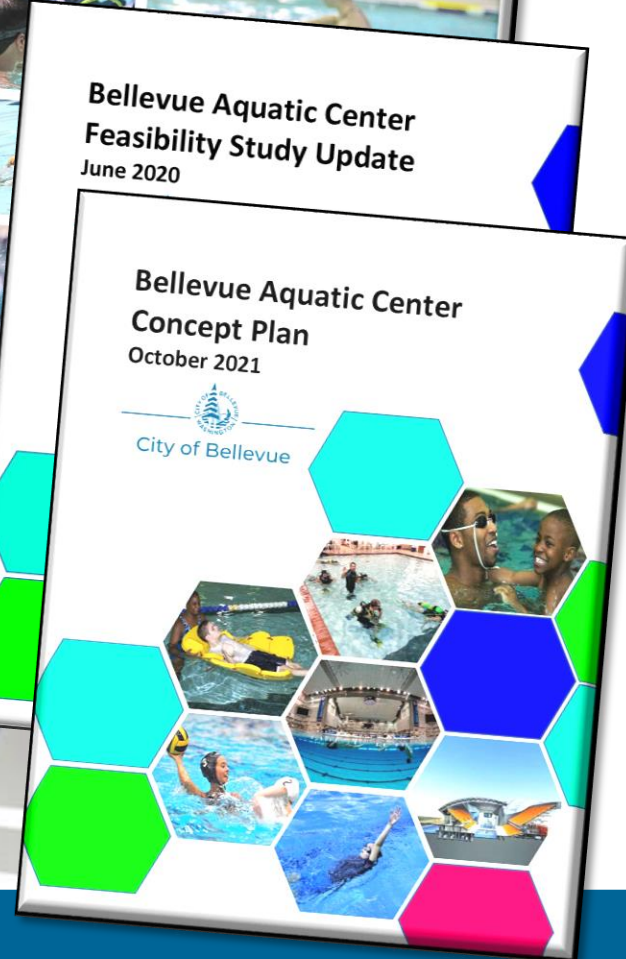
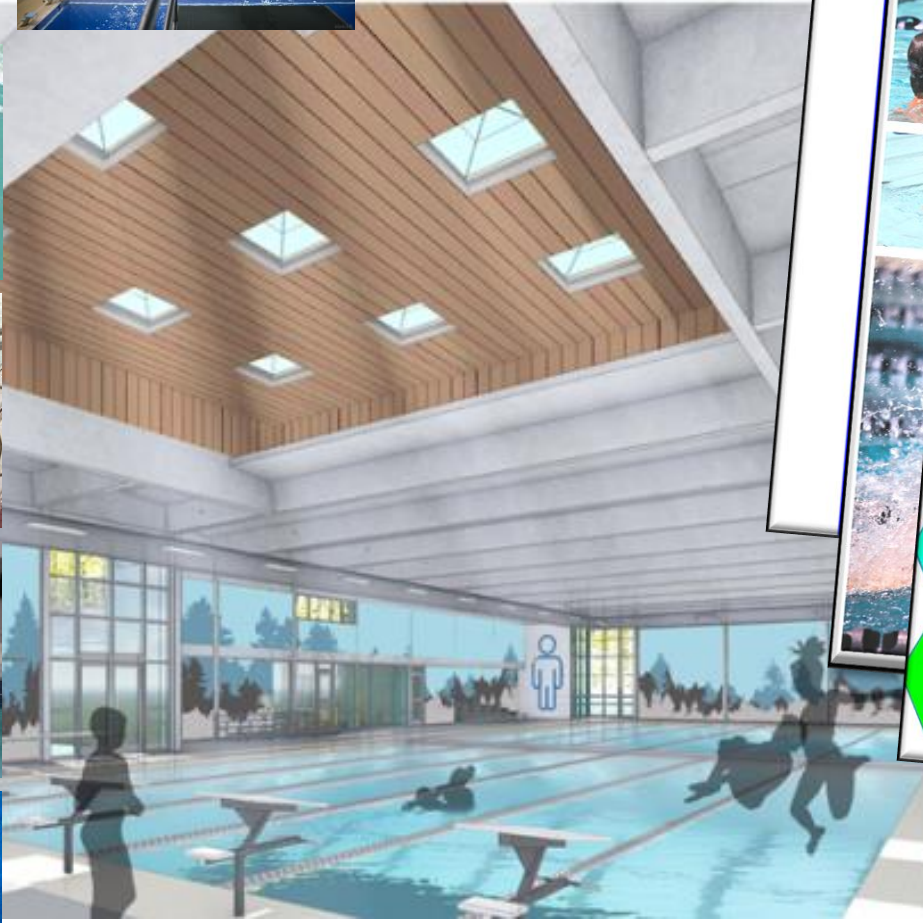

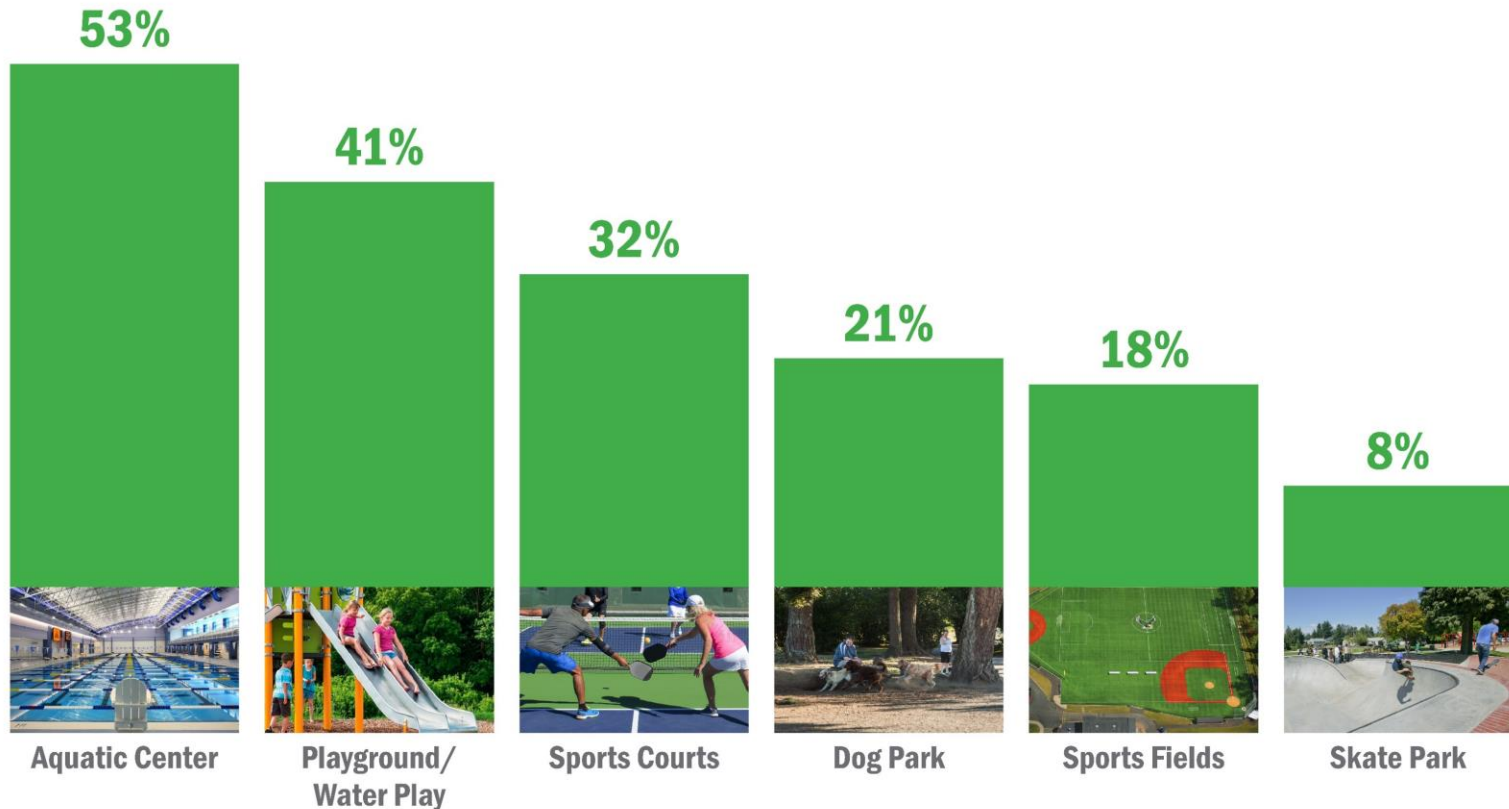

Which passive programs would most interest you in a park site?

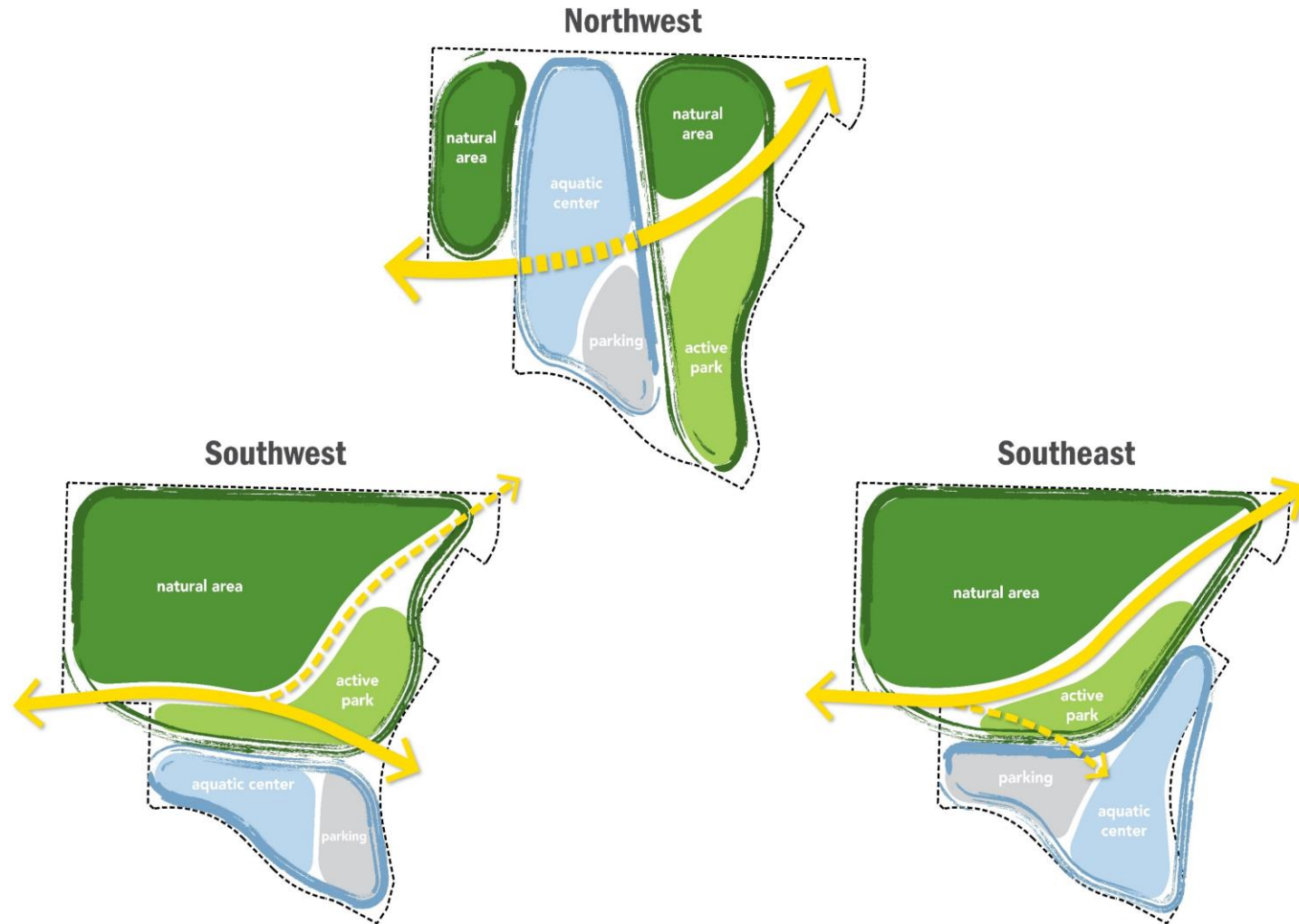

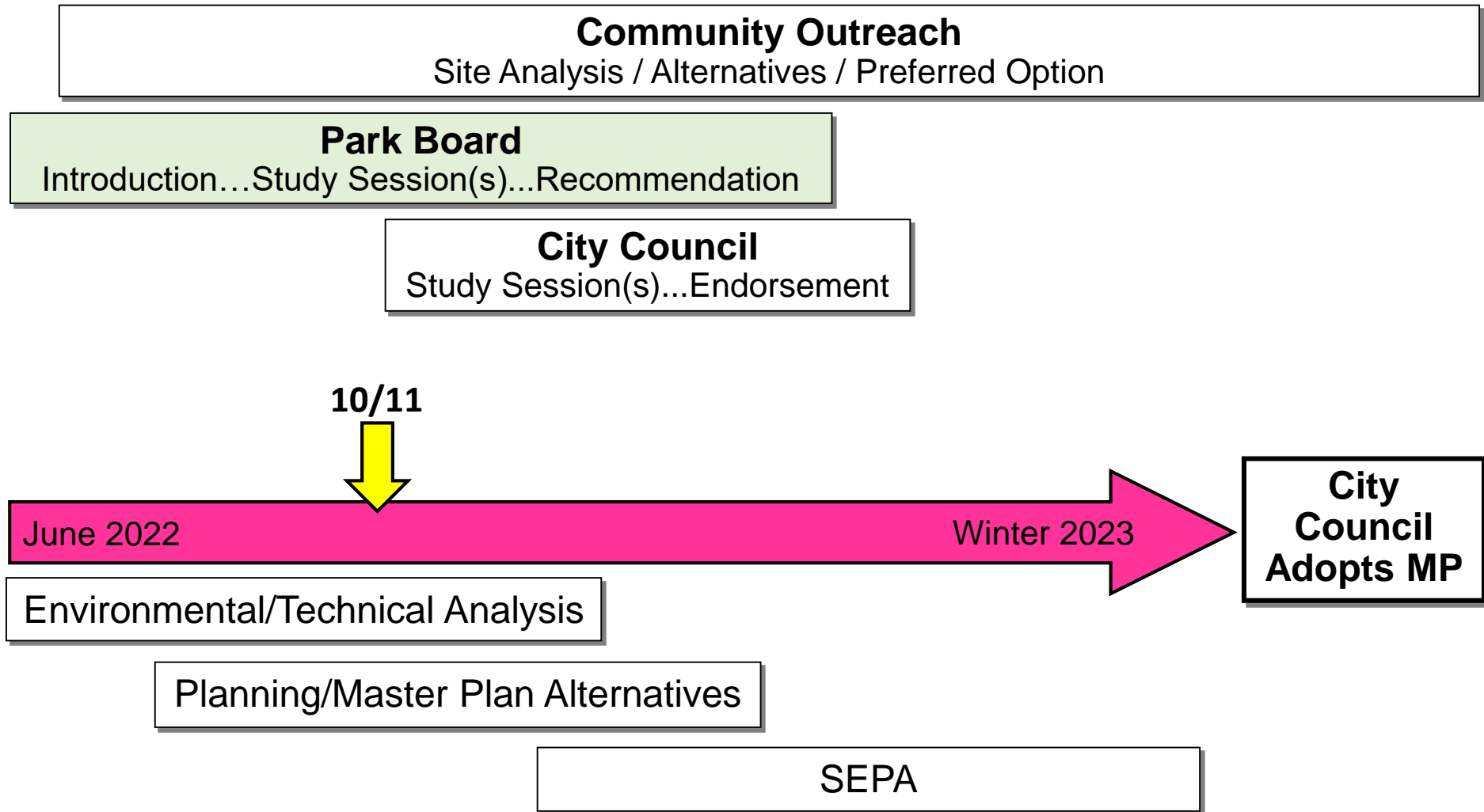
Modified Master Plan
